






Sea Arrivals in 2026 by disembarkation site




Daily sea arrivals last week (16 Mar - 22 Mar 2026)




Sea arrivals by gender and age, Jan 2026




Weekly sea arrivals last year




Asylum applications, Jan-Dec 2025 vs Jan-Dec 2024
