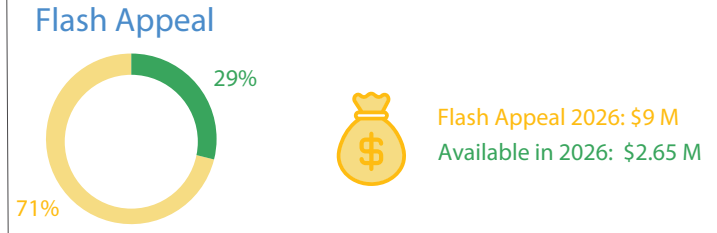
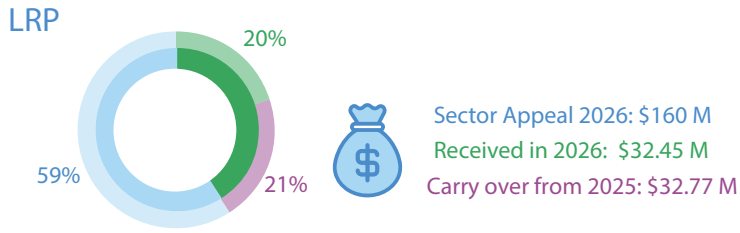


Lebanon Education Sector: At a Glance

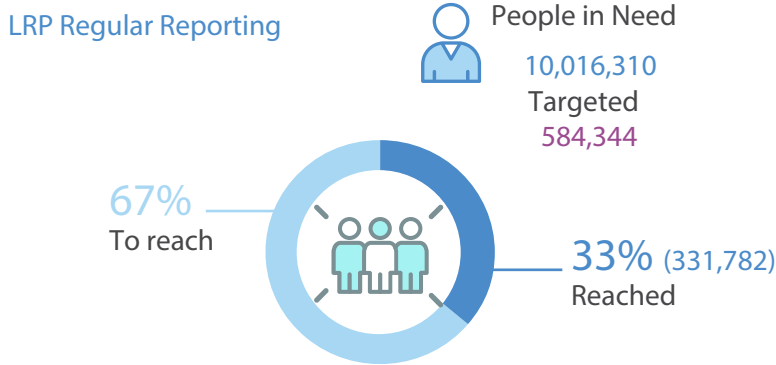
Q1 2026

The Education sector in Lebanon is working towards: OUTCOME 1) Increased equitable and inclusive access to, participation in, and completion of safe and protective education for all learners in Lebanon, with a focus on the most vulnerable children and their caregivers; OUTCOME 2) Improved learning outcomes for children and youth through enhanced quality of formal and non-formal education services that are safe, protective, adapted, and inclusive for multi-crisis situations; and OUTCOME 3) Enhanced governance, managerial and knowledge management capacities of the education system and all education stakeholders to deliver high-level results relying on evidence-based decision-making.

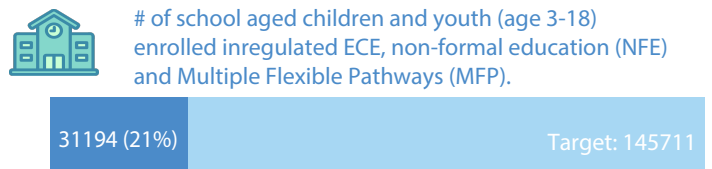
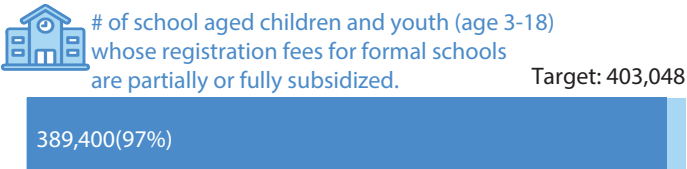
