



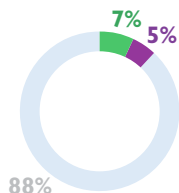
Lebanon Nutrition Sector: At a Glance

Q1 2026

The Nutrition sector in Lebanon operates under the leadership of the Ministry of Public Health (MoPH). Complementing this leadership from the UN and NGO sides, the sector is co-led by the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) and International Orthodox Christian Charities (IOCC) as NGO co-coordinator. 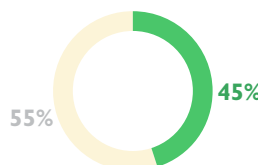
January - April 2026 Sector Funding Status*
