



WEEKLY STATISTICS





Weekly registration: 24-30 June.-2013

- During the current week (24 - 30 June), 101 individuals have been registered; 88 are active. With the introduction of the new GoSS resolution, 13 individuals have been registered and not provided with ration cards in Yida.
- 61 out 101 are newborns.
- 57.5% of new arrivals are minors and 42.5% are above 18 years.
- 44.55% are female, 55.45% are male;
- Rejections: 5 individuals have been rejected this week:**
-The 5 Dafurians have been rejected.
- Transfers:
- 453 individuals were transferred from Yida to Ajoung Thok and 18 individuals previously registered in Pariang were transferred to Ajoung Thok starting off from Yida. No individuals were spontaneous arrival to Ajoung Thok . As of June 30 Ajoung Thok camp host 2,077 refugees.
- Majority of new arrivals come from Heban and Al Boram.

INACTIVATION/RE-ACTIVATION:

- 1 individual was reactivated this week.
- 433 individuals have been inactivated this week because 425 missed May and June GFDs ,4 went back to Nuba,2 went to Juba and 2 to Kakuma.
- No individuals who missed verification were rejected following interviews

Cumulative statistics and trends

- 70,384 individuals, 16,822 households** are registered in Yida camp 65.18% are females head of household and 34.82% are males.
- INACTIVATION (Cumulative):**
- 27.916 individuals have been totally inactivated.
- REFUGEES ON HOLD (Cumulative):**
- **881** have been registered and put on hold (registered without RC).
