This is due to the influx of more than 100,000 Somalis into the Dollo Ado region, and a stream of Sudanese entering the country in the region around Assosa. A steady, but 404,430 significant, number of Eritreans have also entered Ethiopia's Afar and Tigray regions. **Total Refugee Population*** Ethiopia is now host to some 404,430 refugees: the largest groups are Somalis (59 %), Sudanese (7 %), South Sudanese (15 %) and Eritreans (18 %).
