

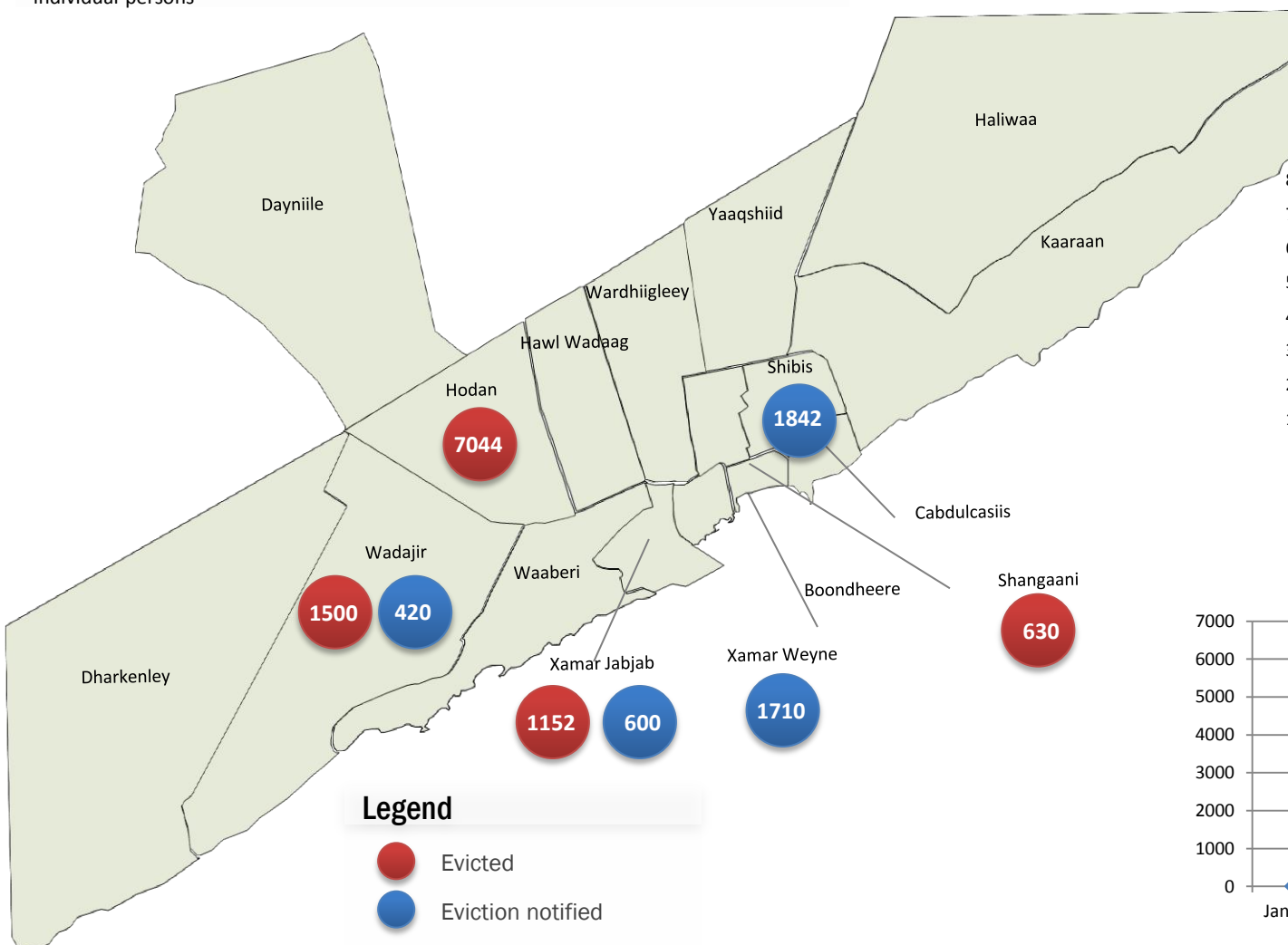
Forced Evictions in Mogadishu – Jan to mid Jul 2014

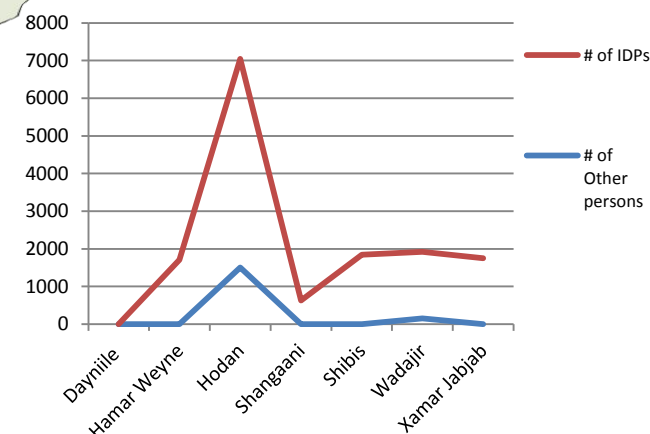

More than 2,483 households (more than approximately 15,000 persons) have received eviction notification in Mogadishu, during the reporting period. Of this number, more than 11,000 persons, mainly, IDPs have already been evicted. Close to 15% of the total number of evicted persons belong to the host community.

In almost all cases, the people concerned were notified orally of the eviction threat. IDPs and others were forcefully evicted mainly from public land that is now claimed by individual persons
