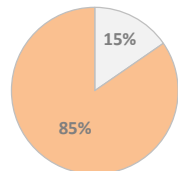

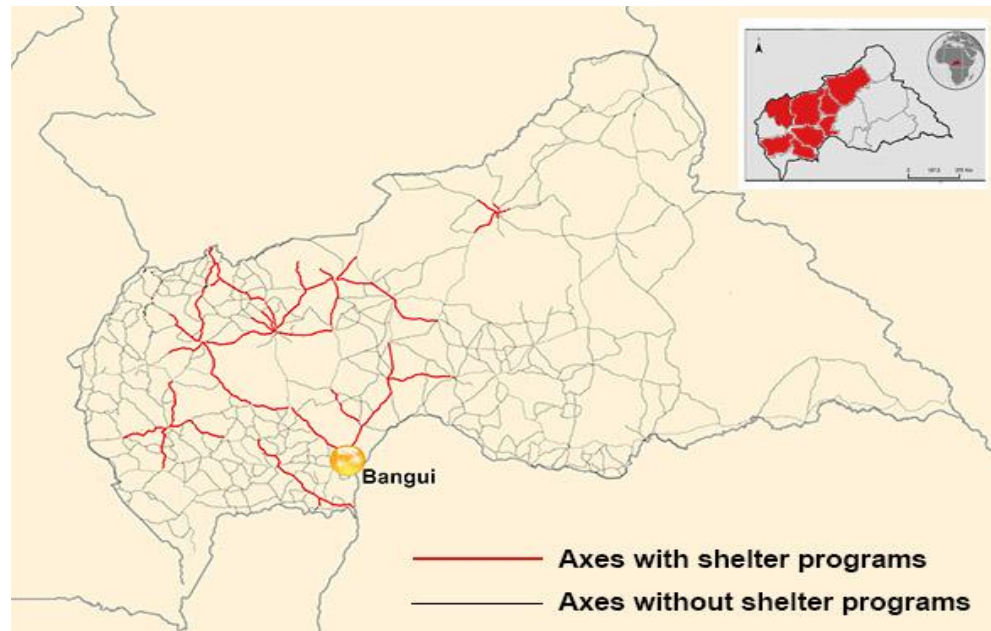
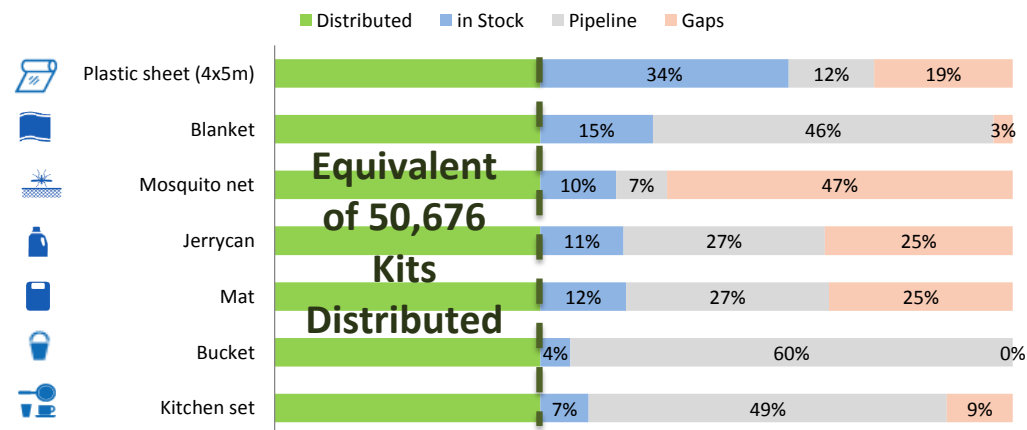

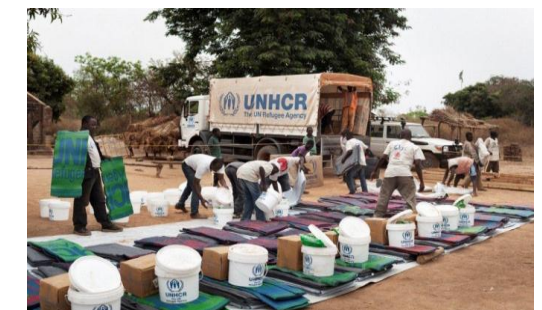
NFI Stock/Pipeline Analysis and Remaining Gap⁵

Response

1. Distribution of emergency shelter and NFI materials to both displaced and returnee populations
2. Construction of communal shelters for displaced populations
3. Shelter reconstruction programmes for returnee populations with severely damaged or destroyed houses
4. Housing, Land and Property support to ensure the respect of ownership rights of displaced populations

Challenges

- Humanitarian access to affected populations continues to be restricted by security concerns, especially in the Ouham Pende, Nana-Gribizi and Ouaka Prefectures;
- Continued displacements caused by the ongoing conflict result in unpredictable and often sudden movements of population;
- Significant logistical challenges exist for operating in CAR due to an underdeveloped road network and a lack of warehousing capabilities.
