



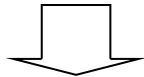

Standard target in Nyarugusu

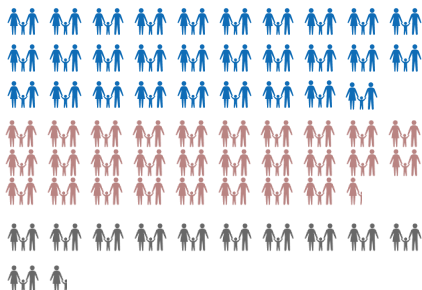

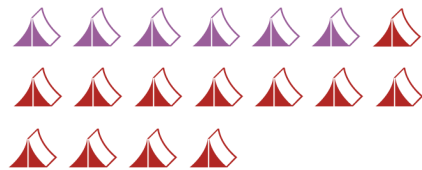


29,000 refugees in tents or family units (mostly shared with 1 other family)

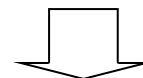
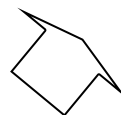
31,500 refugees in mass shelters

6,200 family units built



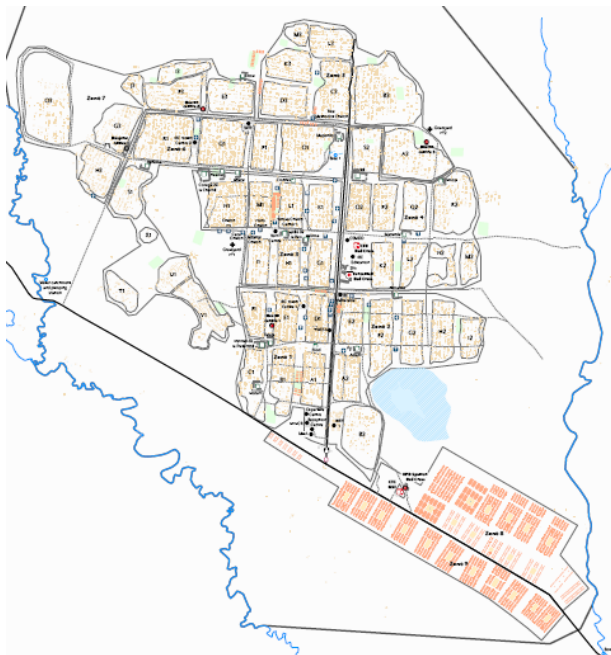

- total number constructed 568
- hosting 4 families each
- Structure with plastic sheeting separation

Shelter types



Emergency mass shelters:

- total number 120
- Communal areas/no separation



Emergency shelters in other buildings

- 15 schools, 4 churches and 6 other centres
- Hosting capacity varies
- Communal areas/no separation



Tents and individual shelters

- total number 3,115 (+900 individual)
- hosting 2 families each (1 family)
- Separation divides the tent in two family units as emergency measure
