

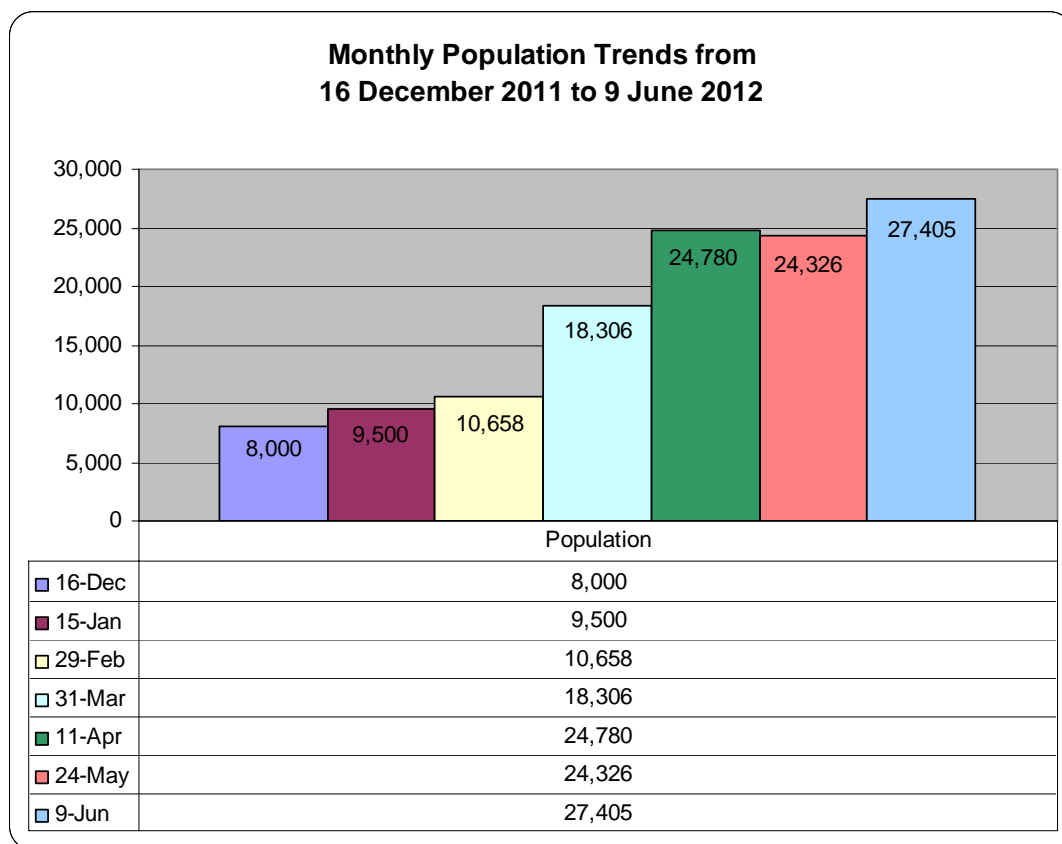


United Nations Country Team in Turkey
Daily Situation Report on the Situation Pertaining to Syria

June 10, 2012

It has been reported officially that as of June 9, 2012 total camp population is reached to **27,405** with the arrival of 118 and return of 23 persons on June 8-9, 2012.

The total number of registered persons from December 16, 2011 to June 9, 2012 is reflected below.

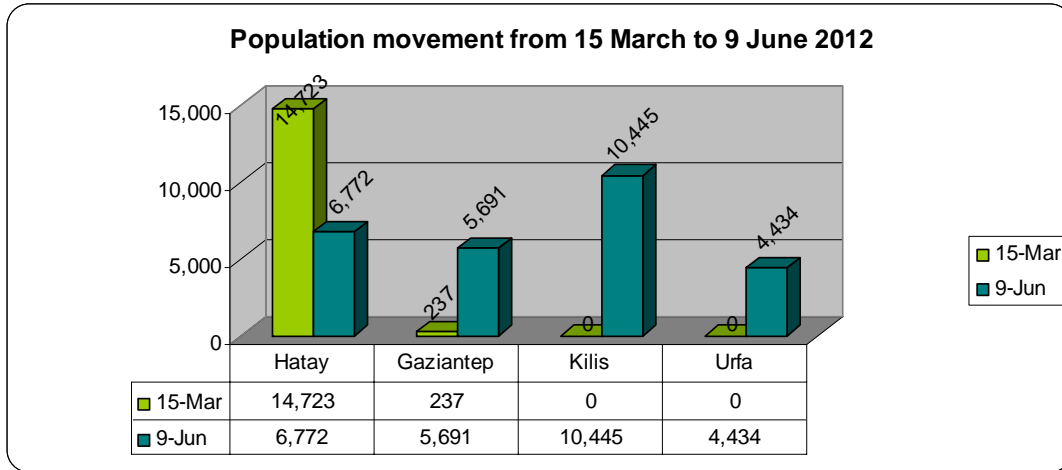


Currently arrivals from Syria are assisted in the border provinces of Hatay, Gaziantep, Kilis and Şanlıurfa.

As of June 9, 2012 the city breakdown in the region is as follows:

- Hatay population* : 6,772 individuals
- Gaziantep population in Islahiye†: 5,691 individuals
- Kilis population in Öncüpinar container site: 10,445 individuals
- Şanlıurfa population in Ceylanpınar: 4,434 individuals

Population movement from Hatay to Gaziantep (Islahiye Camp), Kilis (Öncüpinar Container site) and Şanlıurfa (Ceylanpınar), from March 15[‡] to June 9, 2012 is reflected below.

1. Highlights:

- ❖ Reportedly 4,251 children in Kilis, Öncüpinar Container Site, 805 in Hatay and 600 in Gaziantep, Islahiye Camps are being educated.

*: The population of the Kuyubaşı/Karbeyaz, Yayladağı 2 (YİBO), Altınözü I (TEKEL) and Reyhanlı camps in Hatay is moved to Islahiye camp in Gaziantep and to Öncüpinar container site in Kilis. It has been reported that these empty camps will be kept for while as standby and there is some use of these camps for new arrivals.

‡ 15 March is the date of first movement took place from Hatay.
