

United Nations Country Team in Turkey Daily Situation Report on the Situation Pertaining to Syria

Date: September 14-15, 2012



• No new figures reported by the Government of Turkey. Official figures remained to be 80,177 persons including those under medical treatment in the hospitals as announced on September 13, 2012

• Regional Representative of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs informed that the Syrians who are waiting across the borders of Hatay and Kilis are admitted gradually (about 2,000 persons daily). Reportedly despite the admission of those in groups, the number of people across the border waiting to be admitted remains between 8,000 to 10,000 as there are more people are arriving to the border.

• The new arrivals are referred to the recently opened new camps of Kahramanmaraş and Osmaniye. According to the local authorities the Camp in Adıyaman will also be ready to accommodate in a week.

• Camp management of Akçakale informed UNHCR that they are working to increase the capacity of the camp. According to the official information from AFAD there will be an additional camp in Akçakale with the capacity of 2,200 tents which is estimated to accommodate about 11,000 people. Reportedly it is estimated to be operational by end of September 2012.
