


Highlights

- Official number of Syrians accommodated in the camps remained the same (84,084) as reported by the Government on September 20, 2012 while unofficial estimated figures is around 85,000 persons.
- According to the local authorities as well as the national media the situation across the border of Akçakale is not safe and also creates security problems even for the Turkish side. Houses on the Turkish side are evacuated by the local people and the schools have been closed down until next week.
- Regional representative of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs informed UNHCR that during the last three days, about 500 new arrivals were admitted from Akçakale border, of whom 40 were brought as wounded and hospitalized. Reportedly one of the wounded ones died in the hospital in Turkey.
- The camp officials in Akçakale informed that the new arrivals who have relatives are continued to be allowed to remain with the relatives on permission. According to local authorities, the number of people across the borders of Kilis and Hatay has increased to approximately 12,000 people of whom 8,000 at Kilis border and some 4,000 across Hatay borders.
