


Highlights

- On 04 August 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 20 camps in 10 provinces was 201,018, including 436 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the weekend since Friday 2,433 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps while 2,764 Syrians voluntarily returned to Syria.
- The two coordination Centers in Gaziantep and Sanliurfa provinces informed UNHCR Field Teams that as of 2 August the total number of registered non-Camp Syrians in these two cities was 98,226 including those registered in Nizip town of Gaziantep and in 10 towns of Sanliurfa province. Apart from those who are registered and issued individual ID cards, some 16,701 Syrians were also given appointments to be registered in the coming months.
- Officials of The AFAD Coordination Center in Nizip informed UNHCR Team that they have suspended registering the non-camp Syrians but are issuing appointments. Reportedly as of 02 Aug 2013 appointments were issued for the next 1 to 1/2 months and will continue to do so until the new registration software is installed. Authorities stated that the new software will be applied in all locations.
- On 04 Aug. 2013 the Registration Unit officials in Ceylanpinar camp informed UNHCR that the actual number of Syrians residing in the camp was 15,303 persons. In addition of these refugees, there are also 8,465 Syrians who have been registered in Ceylanpinar camp but have been living outside the camp in urban settings on permission from the camp management. Reportedly, the majority of these Syrians are living in the villages/towns of Sanliurfa province and/or Mardin province.
- In Sanliurfa, the AFAD Coordination Center is registering non-camp Syrians in all 10 towns of Sanliurfa so people do not need to travel to Sanliurfa city center. According to the cumulative figures (24,891) of non-camp registered Syrians in Sanliurfa, as of 02 August 2013, some more that 11,000 (47 %) are living in Sanliurfa city Center, while some more than 7,581 (30%) are living in Akcakale town and its villages along the border.
