


Highlights

- On 20 October 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps in 10 provinces was 200,045 including 90 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the last 10 days (11-20 Oct 2013 - including the Eid period), a total of 5,016 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 5,004 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- Local officials in Gaziantep informed UNHCR that because of the weather conditions (cold temperature and rain) all the Syrians who have been living in mosques and parks in Islahiye and Nizip towns were transferred to camps. Reportedly a few hundred were accommodated in Islahiye and Nizip-1 camps while some were also sent to the Malatya container site.
- Local officials informed UNHCR that there has been an increase in the number of Syrians who approached to the border crossing points to cross to Syria for the celebration of Eid with their family members. Reportedly both from the official customs crossing points as well as various other military controlled safe crossing points several thousands of people were allowed to cross to Syria for the celebration of Eid.
- An international NGO (IMC) opened a medical center in Nizip town and started to provide basic medical check-up and some medicines to non-camp Syrians. Reportedly some Syrians from the camps also prefer to approach this clinic to benefit from the services because of the Syrian doctors working there. The doctors of the center informed UNHCR that on a daily basis about 100 or more persons approach the clinic.
- A UNHCR Team met with a representative of the NGOs Platform in Mardin. Reportedly the platform has identified some 600 families living in Mardin city center and its surrounding villages. The platform had provided assistance including cash assistance, food packages and clothing to these 600 families. In addition to the support to the non-camp Syrians in Mardin, the platform reported that they also sent some food and medical assistance to Syria.
- In Karkamis camp, the camp officials started to replace the tents with the new tents donated by UNHCR for the winterization. Reportedly about up to 75 tents replaced on a daily basis. AFAD Officials in Gaziantep informed UNHCR that the main roads in the camp between the sections will be covered by stones and signs are already put in place showing the various locations in the camp (school, laundry, supermarket etc.).
