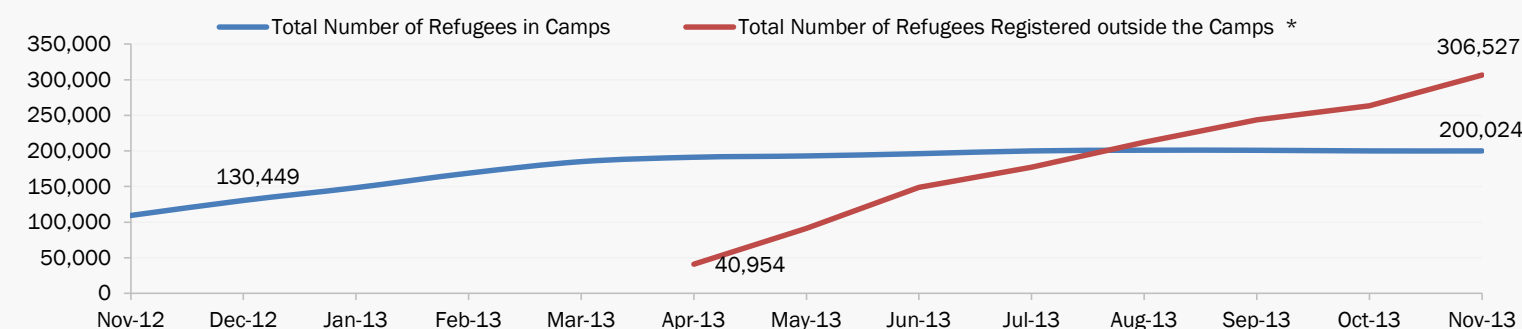

## Highlights

- On 06 November 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps in 10 provinces was 202,379 including 100 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that within a 24hr period from 05-06 Nov. 2013 a total of 1,502 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 415 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- In Ceylanpinar local officials informed UNHCR that they will have a branch office of the AFAD Coordination Center in Sanliurfa in Ceylanpinar town. Reportedly those previously registered in Ceylanpinar camp but living in Ceylanpinar town will be re-registered in this center. If they are living elsewhere (i.e.: Diyarbakir, Batman, Mardin etc.), they will be referred to these respective cities .
- In Ceylanpinar, the camp officials informed that 2 Public health officers previously stationed in the registration unit to vaccinate the children of the new arrivals have been moved to the field hospital in the camp. New arrivals are thus referred to the field hospital in the camp for vaccination of their children.
- In Mardin Midyat camp, officials informed that while they have been re-registering the camp residents, non-camp Syrians living in Midyat town are also registering in Mardin - Midyat camp using the same software. Reportedly, in addition to the camp caseload (3,050 person), they had also registered about 1,100 non-camp Syrians using the same software. However they have not been fingerprinted.
- Local officials (police) in Mardin informed UNHCR that they continue to facilitate the spontaneous returns of the non-camp Syrians approaching them for the facilitation of them safely crossing the border. Reportedly the numbers of Syrians who have returned to Syria voluntarily amounted to 13,222 in October and 820 in the first 3 days of November. Returnees crossed at the Senyurt military-controlled crossing point in Kiziltepe.
