

Highlights

- On 10 November 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps in 10 provinces was 202,545 including 20 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the weekend 08-10 Nov. 2013 a total of 1,184 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 1,071 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- In Gaziantep the registration of the non-camp Syrians, started in Jan 2013 by AFAD and as of 07 Oct 2013 was taken over by the foreigners police. Officials informed UNHCR that since the registration of non-camp Syrians started, more than 85,000 Syrians were registered and issued ID cards of whom 3,156 were registered by foreigners police since October 2013. AFAD registers only the urgent medical referrals and those who are in hospitals under medical treatment.
- In Sanliurfa, the AFAD Coordination Center continues to register non-camp Syrians. Reportedly the foreigners police has not yet started the registration, as their officials are still preparing. The AFAD Coordination Center in Sanliurfa reported that as of end of last week, it has registered more than 50,000 non-camp Syrians, of whom about 40% are living in the city center. In Akcakale town, in addition to the camp population of 26,330, the AFAD coordination center also registered almost 14,000 non-camp Syrians.
- At the request of camp officials, UNHCR provided items to support the vocational courses conducted by the local officials in the camps. The third delivery will provide furniture for the vocational courses and is scheduled to take place during 09-12 Dec. 2013 to the camps in Kahramanmaraş, Nizip 1 & 2, Harran, Akcakale, and Kilis Oncupinar.
- Camp officials in Karkamis informed UNHCR that the replacement of the tents has been completed. The officials reported that 1,663 tents were replaced and an additional 40 were erected to accommodate those who have been admitted from the gate (spontaneous arrivals), as well as the ones who were moved from a mosque in Karkamis town. Reportedly all those living in the temporary tents are provided with family tents.
