

Highlights

- On 17 November 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps in 10 provinces was 202,801 including 52 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the weekend (15-17 Nov. 2013) a total of 1,594 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 1,090 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- Local officials in Kilis are trying to reduce the number of people in the transit center by transferring some of them to Elbeyli Container site. In addition to decreasing the number, reportedly 30 new showers and 30 new latrines are also promised by an NGO to soon be established in the center. Officials informed that food will continue to be provided as hot meals and they were assured by another NGO till mid Feb 2014.
- Following the Ministry of Interior Circular stipulating the police to take over the registration of Syrian refugees, the police started to register the non-camp Syrians in all provinces, with the exception of Hatay where it is only conducting enumeration. In the many places where police started the registration they face technical challenges which slow down the processing and issuance of the new ID cards.
- In Kahramanmaras, before the police took over the registration, they enumerated more than 10,000 non-camp Syrians, and as of end of last week, almost 50% of them were registered. However, due to technical problems, not all of them received their new ID cards. In Kahramanmaras camp almost all the camp residents have been registered. Less than 20% of the camp refugees and only 14% of non-camp refugees have so far been issued new ID cards.
- In Kahramanmaras, the camp officials informed UNHCR that the Governorate of Kahramanmaras organized the sale of products produced by women in the vocational course and the proceeds were distributed to the women. The Governorate is also paying some incentives to the volunteer teachers working the kindergarten (4 teachers) and the school (75 teachers). The school manager of the camp also informed UNHCR that 16 students applied to University and are awaiting the results.
