

Highlights

- On 03 December 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps in 10 provinces was 205,837 including 142 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the 24hrs of (02-03 Dec. 2013) 289 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 245 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- UNHCR met with local officials (AFAD, Deputy Governor and Foreigners Police) who informed that there are 4,850 non-Camp Syrians issued with Temporary Residence Permits and about another 5,000 un-registered Syrians living in the Adana province. The officials informed that they are working to establish a Coordination Center to register all non-Camp Syrians living in Adana. The Social Solidarity Assistance Foundation of the Governorate provides assistance to local vulnerable people and some Syrians are also assisted, including 40-50 persons per day who receive a hot meal from the soup kitchen.
- In Kilis the local police is performing the registration of the non-Camp Syrians and they have thus far registered and finger-printed about 9,500 persons (about 1,800 families). The officials informed that they are issuing about 500 ID cards per day and so far about 1,300 families have been issued ID cards.
- In Gaziantep the registration of the non-Camp Syrians is on-going in the Coordination Center. As of end of Nov. 2013, the total number of registered non-Camp Syrians in Gaziantep city center reached 88,750 of whom 6,877 were registered by the police using the new data base. In addition to this total, about 6,600 non-Camp Syrians have been registered in Islahiye town, and reportedly there are about 3,000 more to be registered.
- Officials in Ceylanpinar informed UNHCR that a fire broke out in Ceylanpinar camp, which was reportedly caused by the misuse of electricity. It was reported that 4 persons were wounded and hospitalized, two of whom are injured by inhaling smoke. In a separate incident in the Ceylanpinar camp, a ten year old child was hit by sewage truck and the child passed away. Reportedly the child was deaf and had not able to hear the horn of the car. The camp officials are considering putting speed limit signs in the camp.
