

Highlights

- On 15 December 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps and one transit center in 10 provinces was 207,990 including 141 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the weekend (13-15 Dec 2013) 3,810 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 1,900 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria. No new numbers reported for the camps by AFAD on 16 Dec. 2013.
- In Sanliurfa, provincial officials informed UNHCR that they continued to register non-camp Syrians living in the province. Reportedly as of 16 Dec. 2013, more than 65,000 Syrians living in Sanliurfa province were registered by AFAD, including 2,793 persons with ikamets (temporary residence permits). Of this total, about 40% are registered in Sanliurfa city center and 24% are reportedly living in Akcakale town.
- During a field visit to Kilis, UNHCR team observed that there are no Syrians left in the Kilis transit center. Reportedly all have been transferred to Viransehir camp. Local officials stated that the center will be closed for renovation and due to harsh weather conditions. Camp officials in Viransehir reported that the camp population increased to 4,478 persons as of 16 Dec. 2013. In Kilis Oncupinar camp, the officials informed that the management identified about 450 unregistered people and because of shortage of space, they will also be transferred to Viransehir camp.
- Officials in Kahramanmaras Camp informed that during the previous week, there was a fire in the camp, and the cause remains unknown. Reportedly six tents burned with no casualties reported. All six tents were replaced with tents provided by UNHCR. The Camp officials also informed UNHCR that some 200 blankets donated by the local community were distributed to the families whose tents were burned.
- Upon request from the camp management, UNHCR will also send heaters to Kahramanmaras camp. Camp officials stated that they need heaters for classrooms in prefabs and rub hall tents used as classrooms.
