



## TARGETS

 **300,000**  
Syrians in camps provided with cooking

 **175,000** Syrians in urban areas provided with cooking facilities

## NEEDS

- Households have access to basic and domestic items (NFIs)
- Persons with specific needs are supported (NFIs)
- Basic needs of Syrian refugees in camps and urban settings are met (NFIs)
- Sufficient supplies received in time (Logistics)
- Establishment of logistics system for contingency purposes, including a central warehouse, core relief items stockpiling and transport arrangements/distribution mechanisms .

## OBJECTIVES

- Population has sufficient basic and domestic needs (NFIs)
- Support to persons with specific needs provided (NFIs)
- Logistics and supply optimized to serve operational needs (Logistics)

## KEY DEVELOPMENTS

The Government of Turkey (GoT) takes the lead role in determining NFIs required for the refugees in camps.

The delivery of the additional 32,500 cooking facilities, consisting of hot-plate cookers, metal cupboards and mini-fridges that were procured directly by UNHCR was completed.

Procurement process of 240,000 high-thermal blankets for winterization assistance by UNHCR is underway.

Procurement of 518 wheelchairs for persons with disabilities by UNHCR is completed. Delivery will be completed within October.

Procurement process for contingency items (kitchen sets, medium blankets, jerry cans, sleeping mats, rubhalls) for 40,000 Syrians has been completed. Delivery of the items to Turkish Red Crescent Society warehouse expected to be completed within October.

Distribution of 18,500 tents that were procured in 2012 to replace the worn-out tents in the camps has been completed.

A central warehouse was identified in Gaziantep for UNHCR distribution/supply and is expected to be operational by October.

Modalities for assessment of vulnerabilities and provision of one-time cash grants for winterization assistance to vulnerable families living outside of the camps are under discussion with the Government of Turkey.

## ACHIEVEMENTS TO DATE

-  **39,500** mini-fridges distributed
-  **36,260** metal cupboards distributed (18,450 in September)
-  **34,760** hot-plate cookers distributed
-  **63,701** children in the camps provided with T-shirts and jeans
-  **3,499** blankets distributed
-  Central warehouse identified in Gaziantep
-  Distribution of **18,500** tents that were procured in 2012 completed
-  Tendering process for **23** mobile coordination / registration centers completed
-  **240,000** high thermal blankets for winterization in procurement
-  **518** wheelchairs procured, pending distribution
-  Contingency items (kitchen sets, medium blankets, jerry cans, sleeping mats, rubhalls) for **40,000** Syrians in procurement.

The Government of Turkey takes the lead role for determining and implementing assistance provided to Syrian refugees, through the Prime Ministry Disaster and Emergency Management Presidency (AFAD). AFAD reports spending over 2 billion USD on the Syrian Refugee Response in Turkey.
