

Highlights

- On 05 January 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps located in 10 provinces was 210,208 including 37 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the period of 02-05 Jan. 2014, a total of 1,621 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 1,529 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- In Viransehir the camp population reached almost 8,000 persons who are registered and accommodated in the family tents. Reportedly another more than 3,000 people are temporarily accommodated in the rub-hall tents inside and outside the camp until they are transferred to Nusaybin. Reportedly Mardin AFAD confirmed that they received the instruction from AFAD Ankara that the Syrians who were temporarily accommodated in the rub hall tents in Viransehir will be moved to Nusaybin camp as of this week. During the meeting with Viransehir camp manager, UNHCR was informed that they are considering vulnerabilities and the unity of the core family members when admitting the Syrians who are at Viransehir camp gate. UNHCR is advocating with AFAD to ensure that vulnerable refugees are not kept waiting outside of the camp and a suitable long term solution is found for them.
- Local officials in Virasehir camp informed that they are expecting confirmation from AFAD HQ in Ankara, that the camp is ready to accommodate at least 3,000 more persons. AFAD HQ informed UNHCR that they have planned to accommodate vulnerable refugees from the non-camp population of Syrians in other provinces. It was reported in the national media that some 200 vulnerable non-camp Syrians were sent from Agri to Viransehir camp during the weekend.
- UNHCR Field Teams were informed by camp officials that the re-registration of the camps' residents into the new system with integrated digital finger printing is almost completed in most of the camps. In Adana the camp management informed that they are still facing technical challenges which delays the registration process as well as the issuance of new ID cards and the implementation of biometric control at the camp gate during exit and entry.
- UNHCR will send 700 heaters to Kahramanmaras Camp upon request from the camp management. In addition to heaters, clothes for the children between 02-17 years will be provided in the coming weeks.
