NEEDS

The NFI working group has defined the following as priority interventions:

- Assess the needs of Syrian families for non-food items;
- Transparent, impartial and orderly distribution in order to avoid duplication thus mitigating frustration and associated security risks;
- Replenishment plans to provide for refugees over an extended period;
- Procurement and efforts to involve the local market.

OBJECTIVES

Ensure that the basic household needs of Syrian refugees in camps and transit sites are met through the provision of NFI assistance, along with the needs of the most vulnerable Syrians living in host communities.

ACTION/OUTPUTS

- 1 Provision of NFI assistance to new arrivals
- Winterization / Summerization
- Full coverage of basic needs in the camp(s)
- Targeted coverage of basic needs in the urban area

KEY NOVEMBER DEVELOPMENTS

- Child Protection and Gender-based Violence training arranged for NFI WG members.
- Joint procurement of gas for winterisation activities offered to group members.
- Coordination of winterization activities outside camps with Cash working group is taking place since the begining of the month.
- Mechanism to prevent duplication of beneficiaries for winterisation developed by UNHCR as an addition to the RAIS database. This includes provision for unregistered Syrians and


