5. Health concerns:

6. Stationary

a. SIB:

- Additional SIB are being distributed across the South based on school directors request . Distribution is ongoing until stock runs out.

Amel: will obtain 14/14/14 SIB

Caritas will obtain: 6/6/6 SIB

NRC: will obtain 3/3/3 SIB

(arrangements for pick up to be organized 2 days in advance for coordination purposes)

b. School bags:

- School bags are being distributed. Expected date of final delivery of school bags is: February 28 for the caza of Saida, Bent Jbeil, Jezzine, Nabatyeh. Marjeyoun , Tyre, Hasbaya pends bags distribution upon confirmation from Amel on the means of distribution.

IP are expected to send the required quantity for school bags and copybooks 2 days in advance for coordination purposes. Furthermore, it's expected that IP's send by end of every day quantity of school bags distributed (specifying # of primary, # of Intermediate), school name, CERD # and district.

7. Referrals:

UNHCR to share with Amel and caritas the accumulated cases followed up upon in order to verify the final status of the case: complete or pending.

8. Reporting:

- Agreed to obtain by every Tuesday of the week bullet points on achievements
- Report bottlenecks, gaps, expected solutions.
- Obtain from NRC the list of schools/schedule of activities
- Obtain from Amel schedule of activities at the center
- Obtain from Caritas, schedule of activities at the schools once ALP/RC start
- Obtain from AVSI (previously communicated) list of schools where they operate.
