

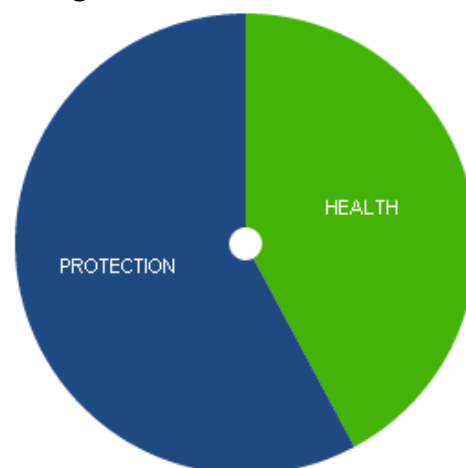

## Un Ponte Per (UPP)

### Mission

Un Ponte per (UPP) is a non-governmental humanitarian organization for international solidarity working in Middle East since 1991, right after the Gulf War. In more than 20 years UPP, in strong connection with local civil society organizations, has organized relief work and promoted cooperation projects in the fields of health, education, recovery of cultural heritages, water and sanitation, psycho-social support, awareness and advocacy for human rights.

The Association is present in Iraq since 1991 and was initially called Un ponte per Baghdad. Its first interventions were emergency projects, health care, educational programmes and other projects aiming at recovering the cultural heritage, supporting civil society and defending human rights, with a special focus on the protection of detainees. Since 2005 Un ponte per... has been active also in Jordan to assist Iraqi refugees and to co-operate with organizations working for women rights. Since early 2012 in cooperation with the Jordanian Women's Union (JWU).



In 2014, UPP has appealed for a total of **USD 376,892**

### Additional Sector Information

In 2014 UPP strategy is to continue and expand the work carried out last year in partnership with the Jordanian Women's Union. Project will focus on the provision of community-based protection services to Syrian refugees with a special attention to women and children.

In the Protection sector services include psychosocial support, legal assistance through counseling and consultations, including GBV case management; child and family protective spaces; women centers; life-skills and empowerment activities; awareness raising sessions;

In the Health sector UPP and JWU are working through two primary health clinics, four reproductive health centers, and one mobile clinic.

In 2014 UPP in partnership with UNESCO launched "Sa'a Suriya", a Radio programme that provides information to the Syrian refugee community in urban areas in the northern and central parts of Jordan, including services provided by different organizations and local institutions with a special focus on services for women and youth. The programme also provide counseling and support through a pool of experts.

### Geographic Focus

Since 2013 UPP is operating in in Amman, Irbid, Mafraq, Balqa, Karak, Madaba, Ajlun, Ma'an and Zarqa in Protection and Health sectors.
