

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF MSNA

The objective of this inter-agency MSNA is to enable effective prioritization of humanitarian assistance by identifying:

1. Priority needs within and among sectors, and
2. Gaps in assistance with respect to these priority needs.

It also aims to inform the RRP6 mid-term revision

TARGET GROUPS (updated)

Syrian refugees registered with UNHCR or awaiting registration

Syrians living in Lebanon who have not been registered with UNHCR

Palestinian refugees from Syria

Vulnerable Local Communities including host communities and Palestinians

Lebanese returnees

TIME LINE (updated)

- ASAP: All data and feedback on info needs received from Sectors
- By March 23: All sector chapters developed (with one day input from Sector Specialists and consultation with all SWGs)
- By March 28: First draft finalised
- By April 14: First draft reviewed and agreed
