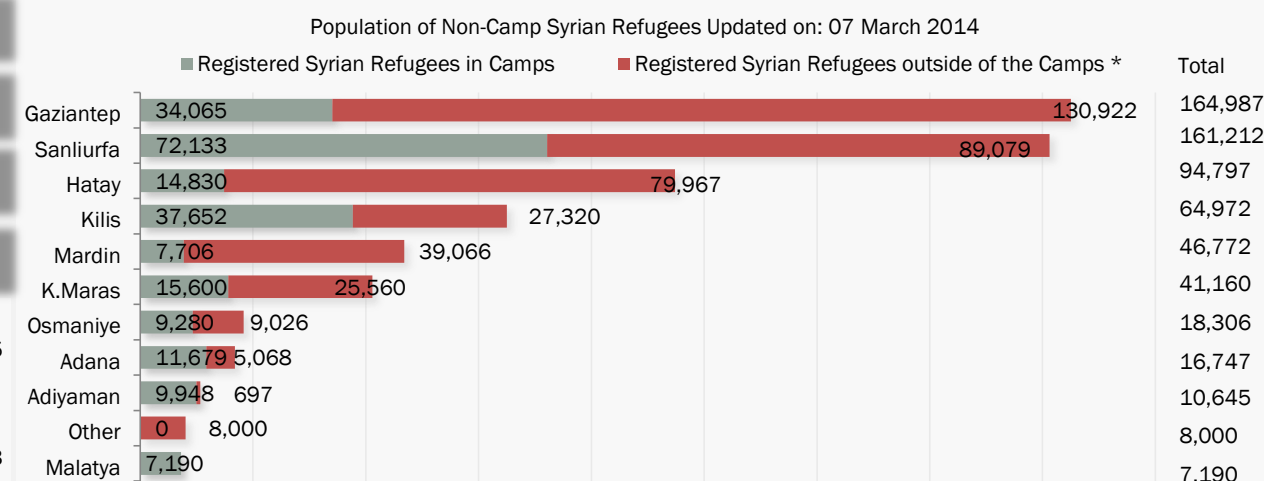
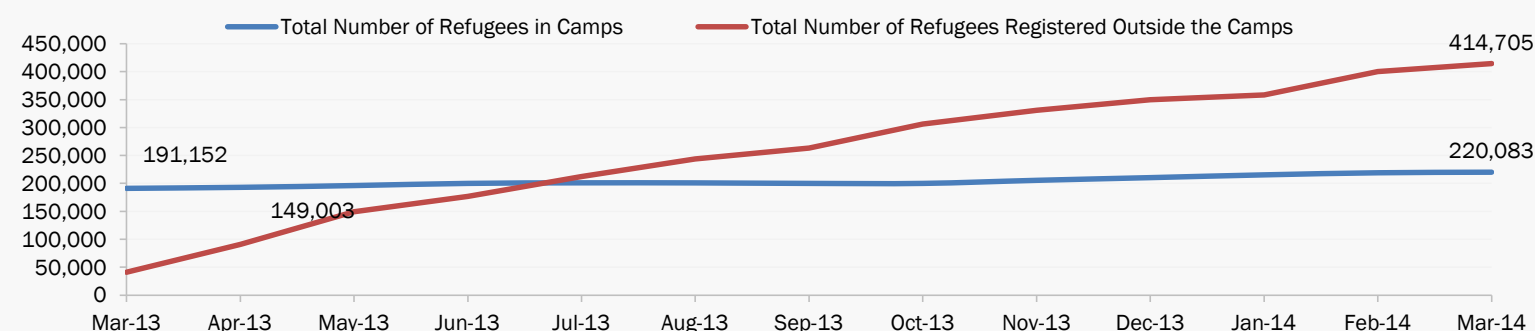

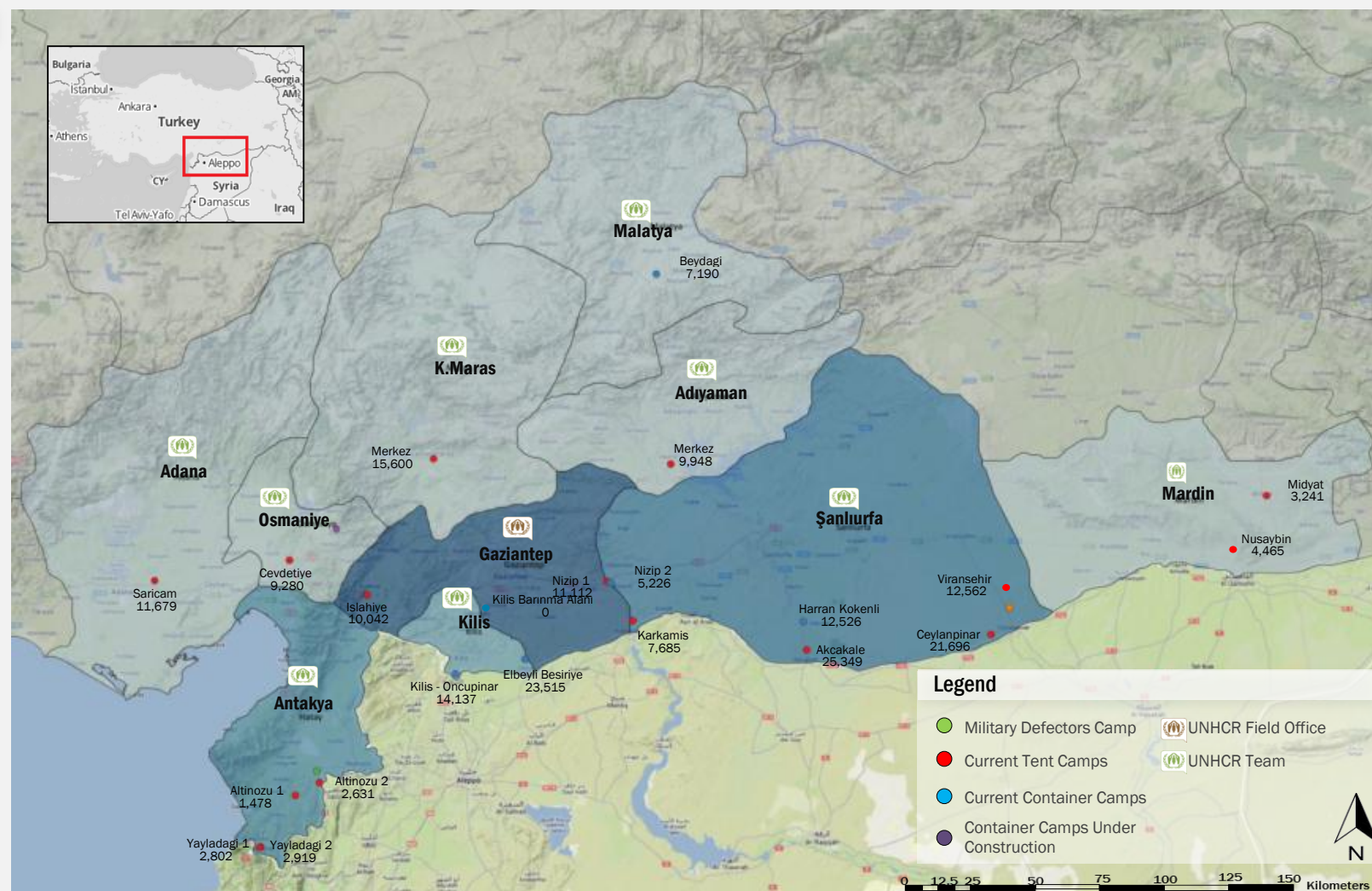


Age & Gender of Registered Syrian Refugees



Highlights

- On 12 March 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 220, 083. AFAD reported that during the period of 11-12 March 2014, a total of 215 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 328 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- In Viransehir, camp officials informed that they received instructions from AFAD Ankara that a group of 360 Syrians will be sent to Viransehir camp from Adana. The camp officials are ready to receive them , but on 12 March 2014 the group had not arrived in Viransehir camp yet.
- In Nusabin camp, officials informed that they have registered 1,266 school-going children, from kindergarten level to 12th grade. However, they are still awaing for the books to be sent by the Syrian Education Council in Istanbul. The education coordinator of the camp also informed that they are planning to start vocational courses in various areas including computer, sewing and hair dressing etc.
- As of 12 March 2014, AFAD reported that about 2,4 million medical interventions were provided to Syrians since the beginning of the crisis. Reportedly of these medical interventions, more than 39,000 were operations, and about 373,000 cases were referred to State hospitals. It was also announced that more than 10,000 births have been recorded since the beginning of the Syria crisis (April 2011).
- As of 12 March 2014, 12 out of 23 mobile coordination units have been sent to the cities (Kilis -2, Gaziantep-2, Hatay-2, Sanliurfa-2 and Kahramanmaras, Osmaniye, Adana and Batman 1 per each). Out of the 12, five are already operational in Reyhanli, Kirikhan, Osmaniye, Islahiye and Akcakale and registering the non-camp Syrians. For the others, officials informed that they are working on technical issues to make them operational.
- In Hatay, Yayladagi, local officials informed UNHCR that they have completed the registration of almost all non-camp Syrians who had been enumerated before. The police also informed that they have started to distribute the ID cards to those registered.
