




Highlights

- On 16 March 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 221,829. AFAD reported that during the period of 14-16 March 2014, a total of 1,657 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 901 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- The registration of non-camp Syrians is on-going in several locations in the southeast. As of end of week (14 March 2014), local officials in Gaziantep informed UNHCR that within Gaziantep province, 132,676 Syrians were registered in Gaziantep province and Nizip town. In Nizip the officials informed UNHCR that despite increasing their registration staff and workstations, and registering about 80 persons per day, they still have about 2,500 people who were given appointments, in addition to more than 19,000 they registered in Nizip town. The officials stated that the earliest appointment they can give is end of April 2014. It was also reported by the officials that the technical infrastructure (data line etc.) for the mobile coordination center is ready and they are expecting the vehicle to arrive in the coming days.
- The camp officials in Nizip-1 informed UNHCR that they still have 546 Syrians who were transferred from the mosque in Nizip town last week are still accommodated in rub hall tents. Camp officials informed that while they are waiting for instructions from AFAD Hq for the transfer of these people, they continue to provide 2 hot meals and breakfast. The camp officials stated they will also do a pre-registration of this group so they can have access to medical assistance when needed.
- In Karkamis, the camp management informed UNHCR that on 14 March 2014 they received about 20 Syrians from Oguzeli town referred by AFAD Gaziantep. Reportedly they were all registered and accommodated in the camp. The camp management stated that they were informed by AFAD Gaziantep Provincial Directorate to organize space for up to 500 more Syrians in case they are referred from urban areas.
- Despite continuous fire-prevention efforts made and fire hazard information provided to the camp residents to be careful, on 15 March 2014 a tent fire caused the death of a 2 year old girl. The investigation into the causes is still on-going while the management suspects it was caused because of misuse of
