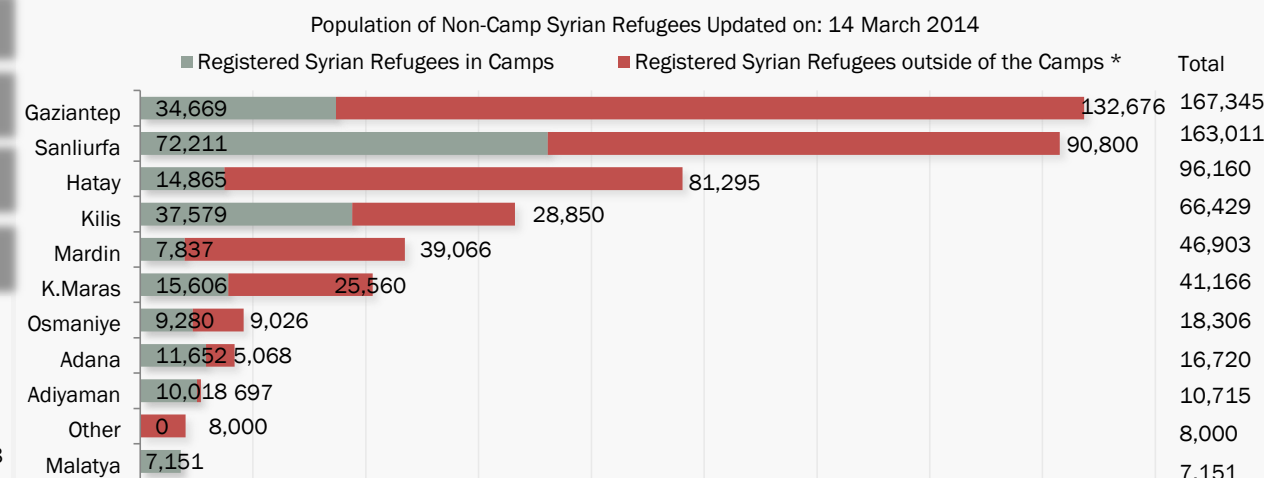
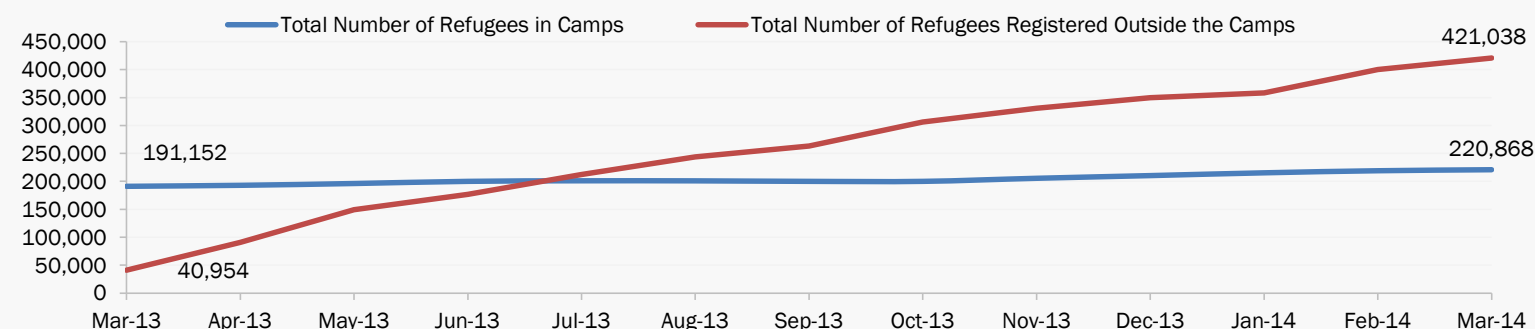

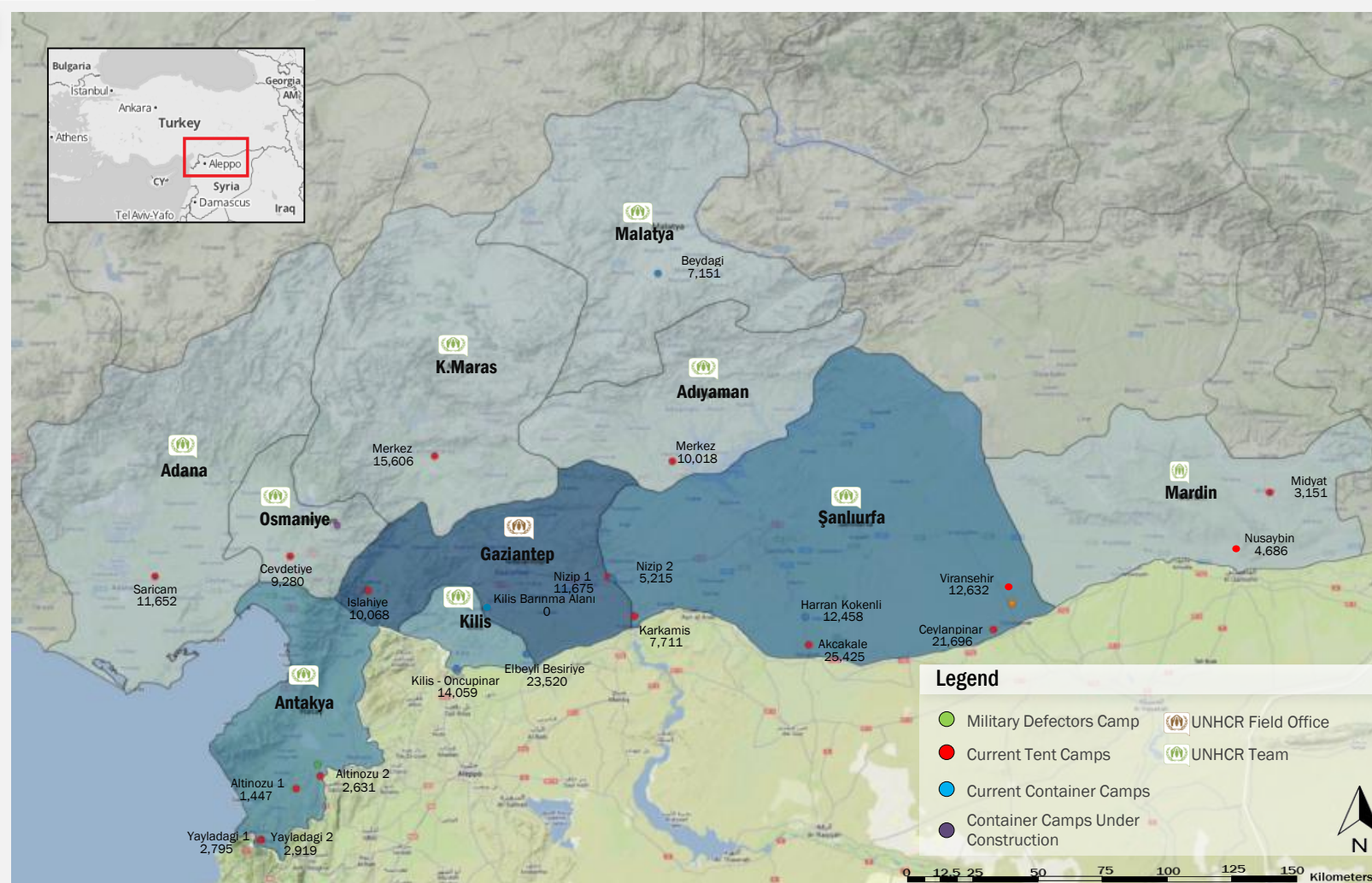


Age & Gender of Registered Syrian Refugees



Highlights

- On 19 March 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 220,868. AFAD reported that during the period of 18-19 March 2014, a total of 515 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 498 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- In Mardin the local authorities informed that they continue to process the voluntary returns of the non-camp Syrians through Senyurt border crossing point in Kiziltepe. Officials stated that these are individuals as well as families who approach them spontaneously and during the period 01-18 March 2014, they have facilitated the voluntary return of 5,829 Syrians from Senyurt Kiziltepe to Deyr-Bassiyah.
- Local officials of SASF (Social Assistance and Solidarity Foundation) office in Mardin informed that in addition to 750 kg of coal assistance to over 1,100 families, they also distributed 1,400 blankets (1,200 in city center and 200 in Kiziltepe) to non-camp Syrians in Mardin province. Authorities also informed that they received 264 pairs of boots and distributed these to Syrians in need. Reportedly all this assistance is provided through local NGOs.
- In Midyat camp, officials informed that the construction of the prefabricated school funded by UNICEF has started. Reportedly the school will have 12 classrooms. In the camp, officials registered 987 children of school age, including 24 children living in Midyat town. The camp also registered 521 adults for various vocational courses like sewing, embroidery, hairdressing classes. For the pre-school classes 80 children were registered.
- In Akcakale, the registration of the non-camp Syrians living in town is conducted in a tent at the entrance of Akcakale camp. The officials informed UNHCR that as of 14 March more than 20,352 non-camp Syrians have been registered. Officials in Akcakale also informed that the registration of non-camp Syrians is done by both police and also AFAD in order to provide assistance in an effective way. Reportedly about 3,500-4,000 families were identified for support through donations received from private donors.
