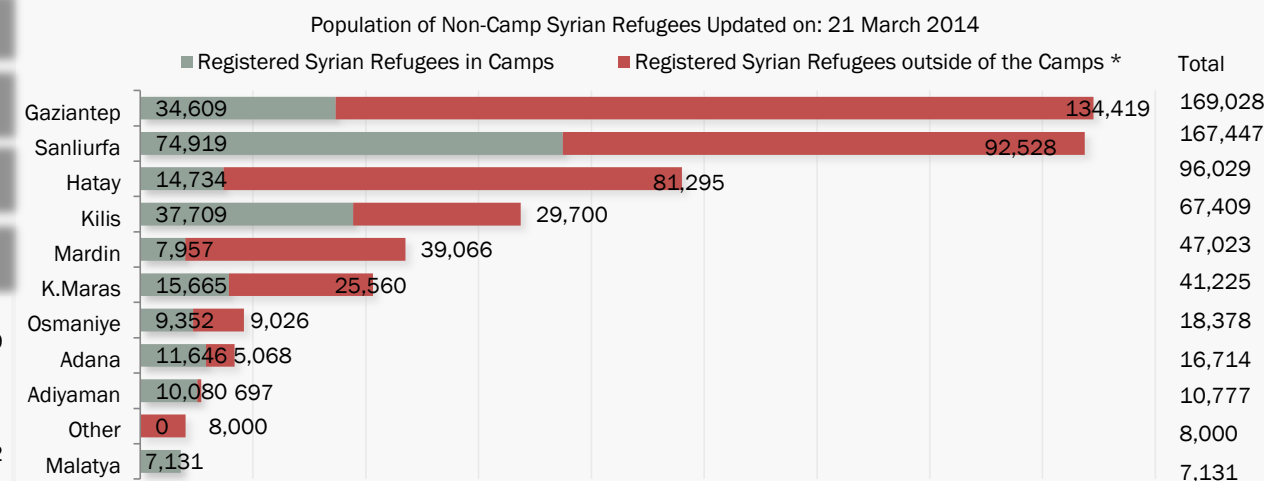
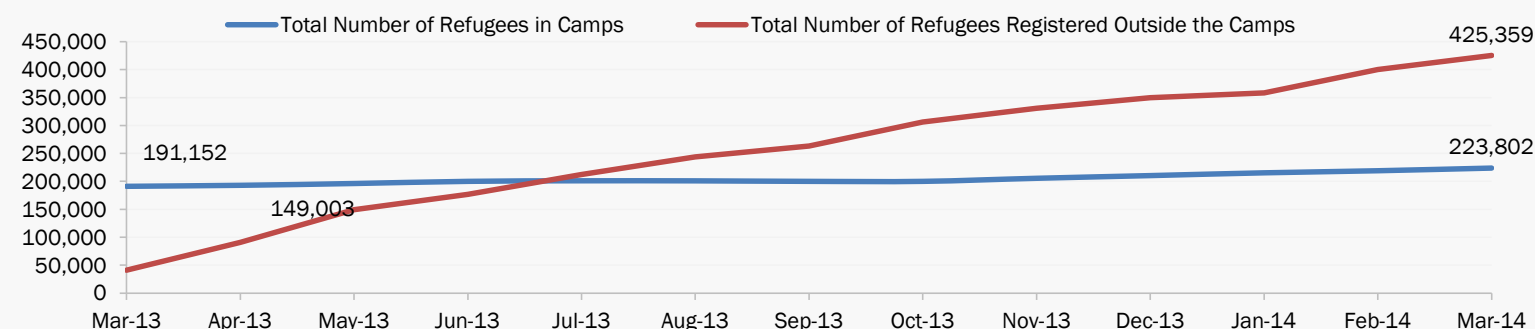

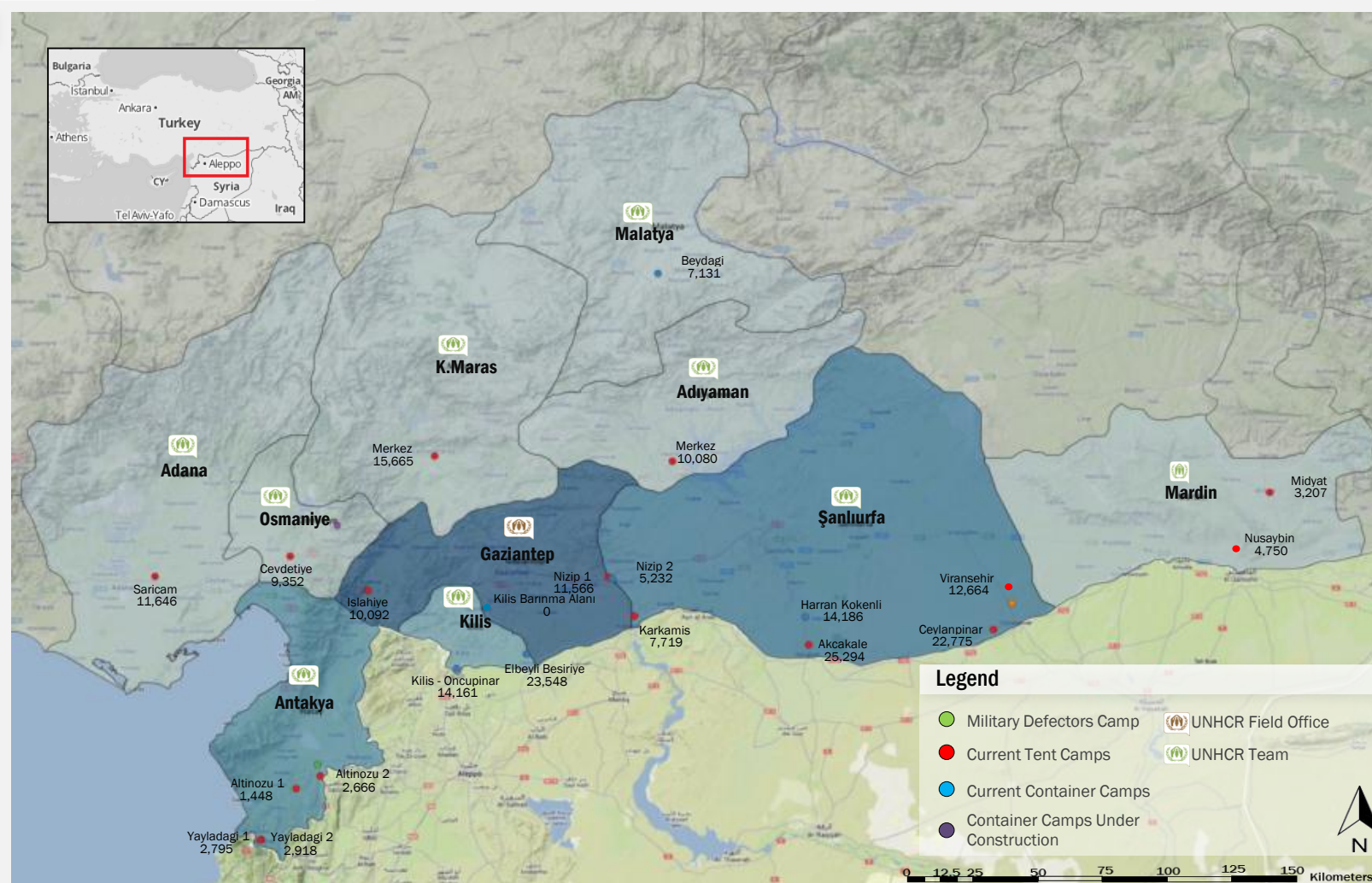

Highlights

- On 25 March 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 223,802. AFAD reported that during the period of 25-26 March 2014, a total of 820 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 568 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- Local authorities in Sanliurfa Province informed that the 2nd Mobile Coordination Unit sent to Sanliurfa was initially to be based in Suruc, but it was decided to send it to Siverek. Authorities informed that they are working on technical preparations and it is planned to be operational after the elections. According to local authorities about 5,000 Syrians are living in Siverek town and some 3,000 are already enumerated by AFAD.
- In Osmaniye, officials informed UNHCR that the number of registered non-camp Syrians in the mobile coordination unit is now around 2,500 persons, while provincial AFAD previously enumerated some 9,000 Syrians. The estimated number of Syrians in Osmaniye almost double (17,000 persons). In Kilis, the number of non-camp Syrians registered by police in the 2 mobile coordination centers located in town reached over 29,000 as of 25 March 2014.
- In Viransehir camp, officials informed that, as instructed by AFAD HQ, 35 Palestinians of whom 20 are young males were transferred to the camp and they were all registered and accommodated in the camp. Reportedly this brought the total number of Palestinian origin refugees to 70 in the camp. In Nusaybin, the camp officials reported that they received instruction from AFAD Hq about the transfer of 100 Syrians from Istanbul however as of 26 March 2014, there were no arrivals yet.
- In Gaziantep, the provincial AFAD Directorate is transferring non-camp Syrians living in dire conditions in the city center to the camps in Gaziantep. In addition to those who were transferred to Nizip-1 and Islahiye camps, some 160 Syrians were transferred to Karkamis camp. These Syrians are accommodated in rub hall tents and provided food and medical assistance when needed, until they are transferred to another camp, depending on the availability of space in these 3 camps.
