

Total camp area is 1,530,000m², including facilities, roads, etc. as well as Phases and Transits currently under construction, but not Phase 6. Total population of the camp as of May 2013 is 40265. The average area per person is then 38m². UNHCR Handbook for Emergencies (2007) recommends a minimum of 30m² of surface area per person and this standard is overall met.

Normalising population density to only include inhabited Sectors, a value of 23m²/person has been identified as equivalent to the above standard. Considering population density on a per-Sector basis shows where individual camp Sectors fall relative to the standard proportionately to their area. Sectors meeting the standard are shown in green, Sectors not meeting the standard are shown on a scale of yellow to red.

Average size of family is considered to be 4.5.
