



Total Number of Refugees Registered and with Registration Appointments	773,935

Highlights

- On 12 June 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 219,167. AFAD reported that during the period of 11-12 June 2014, a total of 391 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 320 Syrians voluntarily returned to Syria.
- Officials in Kirikhan town of Hatay informed UNHCR that the number of non-camp Syrians registered in the town reached more than 22,000, while a local NGO estimates that there about 35,000 Syrians in the town. In Reyhanli, the number of registered non-camp Syrians is close to 42,000. Out of 12 mobile coordination units sent to the field, two mobile coordination units were stationed in Kirikhan and Reyhanli towns of Hatay.
- In Kirikhan, officials estimate that about 20% of registered non-camp Syrians in Kirikhan are school-age children. However, due to shortage capacity in the existing schools, only about 40-45% of the children can attend the Syrian-run schools that are funded by faith-based foundations in the town. In order to respond this need, officials said that a private sector Turkish company is in contact with local authorities and plans to build a school in town.
- One of the two mobile coordination centers sent to Gaziantep province was initially stationed in Islahiye and the other one is stationed in Nizip town. UNHCR was informed that the center in Islahiye was moved back to Gaziantep city center and will be stationed in one of the city center locations after undergoing some technical updates. This will decrease the burden on the other coordination center already in Gaziantep city. The coordination center in Nizip is currently being used to register new arrivals and re-registering those who were registered/enumerated in Nizip town before.
- During the visit to the mobile coordination unit in Nizip, officials informed UNHCR that more than 21,000 non-camp Syrians have been registered and/or enumerated as living in Nizip town. As of 12 June, it is reported that about 7,000 Syrians have been re-registered in the new software system while others are also being re-registered. In Islahiye, although the mobile registration unit was moved to Gaziantep, the registration of non-camp Syrians is ongoing. As of 12 June more than 8,000 Syrians have been registered in Islahiye, including those who are
