



Total Number of Refugees Registered and with Registration Appointments	808,600

Highlights

- On 23 July 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 218,755. AFAD reported that during the period of 22-23 July 2014, a total of 422 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 411 Syrians voluntarily returned to Syria.
- In Karkamis camp, officials informed UNHCR that a group of about 37 Syrians who were residing in the mosque of a nearby village (Gurcay village) were admitted to the camp and registered. In addition to those 37 persons, another family (a pregnant woman with three children) who was visiting relatives in the waiting area of the camp (staying temporarily in a visitor's container) refused to leave, as she claimed to have no place to go. Due to her vulnerability (being pregnant), the camp management also admitted and registered her in the camp.
- A UNHCR Field team visited a Syrian school in Kilis. The school staff informed the UNHCR team that, in addition to the school building provided by the municipality, they are supported by local NGOs (International Blue Crescent, Kimse Yok Mu and IHH) and the local governorate. The school provides education for 1st-6th grades and had about 500 Syrian children registered last year; this year they are expecting to register up to 700 children. The school manager informed UNHCR that they had about 18 Syrian teachers (12 female and 6 male) last year but may have more teachers this year.
