



Total Number of Refugees Registered and with Registration Appointments	822,499

Highlights

- On 11 August 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 217,630. AFAD reported that during the period of 10-11 August 2014, a total of 419 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 65 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- According to the official numbers from the local authorities in the southeast, the number of non-camp Syrians registered increased to around 605,000 persons. Reportedly about 63 % of these are registered by the police while the rest have been initially registered/ enumerated by AFAD and their re-registration is on going. In the provinces in the southeast the registration of non-camp Syrians by police is also taking place in 10 mobile coordination centers in 9 provinces. According to local authorities in Adana province they have increased the working hours of the registration to two shifts (16 hrs./day), while the second mobile coordination center will be activated soon to speed up the registration.
- WFP post-distribution monitoring (PDM) and beneficiary contact monitoring (BCM) forms were reviewed jointly with AFAD and are now in use. Monitoring activities using the new forms began in all camps this week.
- WFP/TRC are continuing the joint assessment of various shops outside of camps in regions where shop quality, prices and standards have been an issue. In July alone, WFP/TRC contracted six new shops in urban centers which are now operational.
- In Nizip town, a UNHCR team met with the head of religious affairs office who informed that his office is providing food and non-food items to about 100 families per day. Reportedly the office of the religious affairs has about 3,647 families registered that receive assistance depending on resources and private donations the religious affairs office receives.
- There have been incidents between Syrians and the local community in some of the provinces in the southeast region, which have led to demonstrations against Syrians in Gaziantep and Sanliurfa. On Monday it was reported in the media that a local landlord in Gaziantep was stabbed to death by his Syrian tenant over a dispute. The authorities have sharply condemned these demonstrations and are continuing to promote tolerance and peaceful coexistence between the communities. UNHCR met with the local authorities in Gaziantep and Sanliurfa and expressed its support to the local authorities to reduce the tensions.
