



Total Number of Refugees Registered and with Registration Appointments	847,266

Highlights

- On 14 September, AFAD, the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Turkey's Government, announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in the 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 220,110. AFAD reported that from 11 to 14 September, a total of 337 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 567 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- UNHCR was informed by the Islahiye camp management of the arrival of a 70 Syrians refugees group who were transferred to this camp following a dispute with their employers in the agriculture fields nearby Islahiye town. Upon arrival they were offered temporary accommodation in the waiting area of Islahiye camp until they could be transferred to the new camp being built also in Islahiye. However, according to camp officials many members of the group have indicated they do not want to stay in the camp.
- Camp officials from various camps informed UNHCR that all the teachers working in the camp schools in the new semester are volunteers. Therefore, in order to encourage and motivate them, they are seeking possible resources to provide them with cash incentives.
- In Adiyaman camp, the vocational courses are on-going. The sewing classes output is adjusted according to requests of the private textile sector companies and each course attendee is paid according to the number of pieces they produced. Camp officials informed UNHCR that a private textile company agreed to support each attendee with 500-600 TL per month even though they do not have put in a production request.
- Adiyaman camp officials informed UNHCR that they are in need of hot-plates for cooking to replace broken ones. The camp management had them repaired to the extent possible; however several hundred can no longer be repaired. UNHCR is in the process of procurement of hot-plates for cooking not only to Adiyaman camp, but also to other camps upon request.
