### **1. Review previous minutes and action points:**

The minutes and action points from previous meeting agreed and endorsed.

### **2. SCJ outreach presentation**

SCJ made a presentation on 2014 “back to school campaign” which is under one of the outputs for their “education for all” program. The presenter provided sector members with overview of the activity, objectives, and achievements, reasons hindering Syrian children from enrolling into school, number of students reached and recommendations. ### **3. Presentation on informal education mapping**

UNICEF shared preliminary results of informal education mapping which was conducted this year. The focus of this mapping was out of school children and providing them alternative learning opportunities. The presenter shared objectives, overview, methodology, key findings and recommendations of the mapping exercise. The presentation will be shared after the meeting. (Attached)

### **4. Updates from the camps**

#### **Azraq**

- SCJ is continuing with psychosocial activities at the camp
- FCA is continuing to run their numeracy and literacy for youth projects. A total of 100 youth are attending these sessions.

#### **Zaatari**

- Mercy Corps has integrated 25 CWDs in their schooling programs
- Mercy Corps conducted child to child sessions for 4<sup>th</sup> grade students
- Mercy Corps also conducted orientation for shadow teachers, providing them with on job training.

### **5. Elections of new co-lead: Criteria and timeline**

The ESWG is in the process of selecting a new co-lead for the sector. Currently, criteria and process for selection of co-lead is being drafted and the selection will be done by the end of the year. The criteria will be shared with sector members for feedback.

### **6. AOB (Update on JENA workshop in Zaatari, update on 3RP, Expression of Interest by UNICEF, AI reporting and monitoring).**

- JENA workshop in Zaatari- This was conducted on November 30, 2014 in Zaatari. Participants came up with action points for the recommendations of the assessment. This will be used to address issues raised in the report.
- UNICEF is putting together EOI for informal and non-formal and inclusive education projects. They welcome applications from new partners outside of their usual implementing partners



- ActivityInfo reporting- Agencies need to report better. A meeting will be called for those reporting on AI.
