Agency updates

UNICEF

- Significant change in long term staffing across many organizations meaning implicit loss of WASH institutional knowledge and experience.
- UNICEF requests WASH partners (Acted & Oxfam) to complete fencing for transformers ASAP so that further process for electricity connection can progress.
- UNICEF seeking national and international staff for the Berm. Job adverts have been shared. Feel free to share with interested/potential candidates.
- PCA funding length will be reduce to nine months, ending Dec 2016
- CfW injury discussed between UNICEF and UNHCR and request to create a WASH sector safety plan.
 - AP: partners to provide individual information to UNICEF to review prior to NBWG. Nicolas, Cendric, Junko, Diana and Habib are organizational focal points and will pass information to Habib.
- Health sector person absent
 - AP: UNICEF request to Diana to ensure someone to attend all WASH meetings. Person is not required to be from UNHCR every time.

- WWN HH connections ongoing in D11 and D12
- Water tank disinfection, D9, D10 completed D11 ongoing
- 32km pipe laid, 450 PRC tanks are installed and total 500 PRC tanks are delivered.
