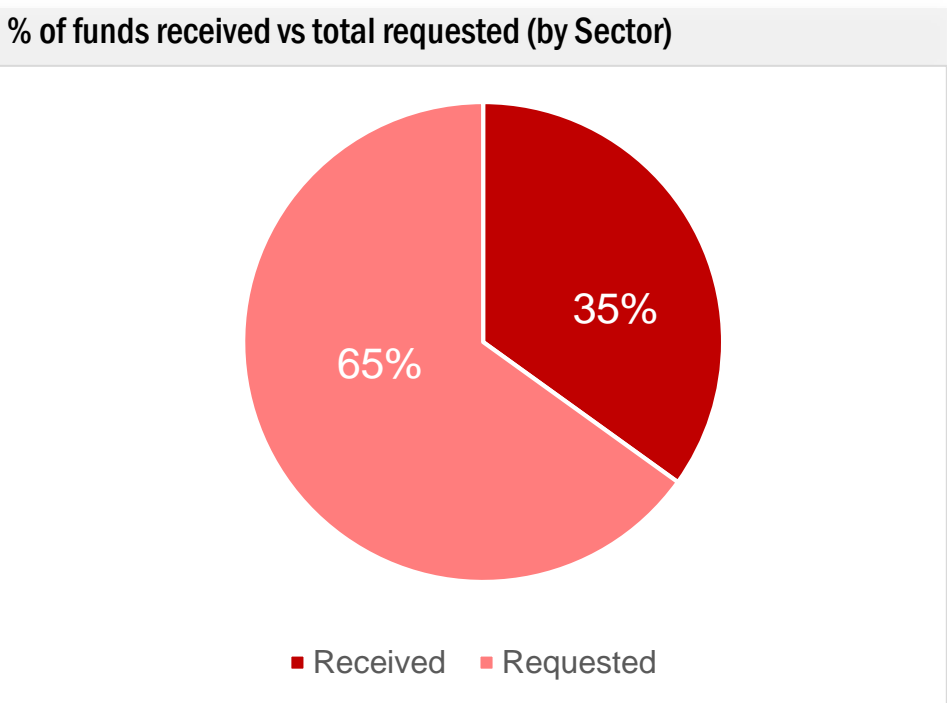

Funding Status

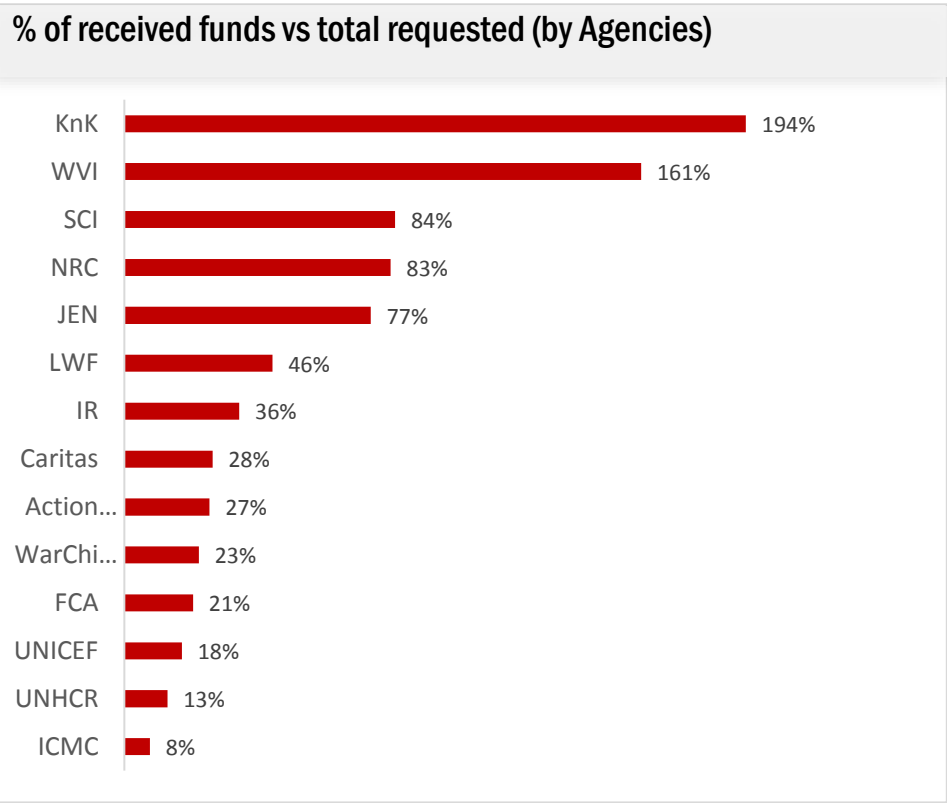
