Mapping of local Community Based Organizations per governorate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A list of CBOs can be obtained from the Ministry of Social Development however they are not always active • Governorates per CHTG members are as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Mafrq - Mapping in Mafrq is going on by ACTED; will send in a few days ii. Zarqa - PU AMI; Dan will circulate a map for the CBOs they are working with and will look for more iii. Ramtha – MDM; received a list of clinics but still working on CBOs iv. South Jordan - Save the Children; Heba to send in a few days' time v. Amman - Handicap International; working on this vi. Jerash - JRC and IFRC; information is being compiled into English vii. Irbid – Medair; work in progress viii. Balqa - ? Oxfam; Elsa to follow up with Doa'a 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dan to follow up with his team if this list is available

Agency updates	<p>Updates from agencies (only major updates)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medair: continuation in current program, more focus on CBOs. This month in May distribution of health and hygiene kits and diapers to vulnerable refugees and Jordanians in the community. Target: 600 HH • MdM: started mobile clinic in Ramtha. Schedule attached with this minutes • SCJ: extension until end of June and hopefully beyond that. All else the same. Arranged for 3 workshops for MoH and 2 are done already in Aqaba and in Amman. Next week it will be done in Karak for midwives, nurses and nutritionists on IYCF. • IRD: finished funding MoH training in RH, dental health, communicable and NCDs, violence (262 nurses, doctors and midwives) in all governorates in the north. Other activities are continuing as usual. Health educators are continuing in violence, women's health breast cancer done for waiting patients in health facilities • IRC: planning to add more CHVs in Irbid and Mafraq with more focus on Ramtha. Will be deploying a 3rd mobile outreach clinic from next month targeting disabled people and doing home visits • JRC/GRC: project is ongoing until end of June; another project is planned for but waiting for confirmation from the donor. Would start in July for 18 months and would extend out of Irbid city into some rural areas • JRC/IFRC: ending the baseline in Madaba, Marj al Hamam and in Jerash. Started in Mafraq and to start soon in new areas in Amman and in Ajloun
