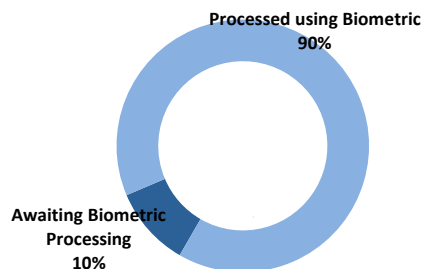

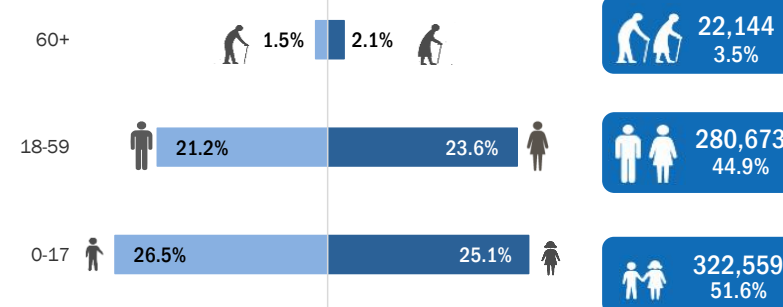

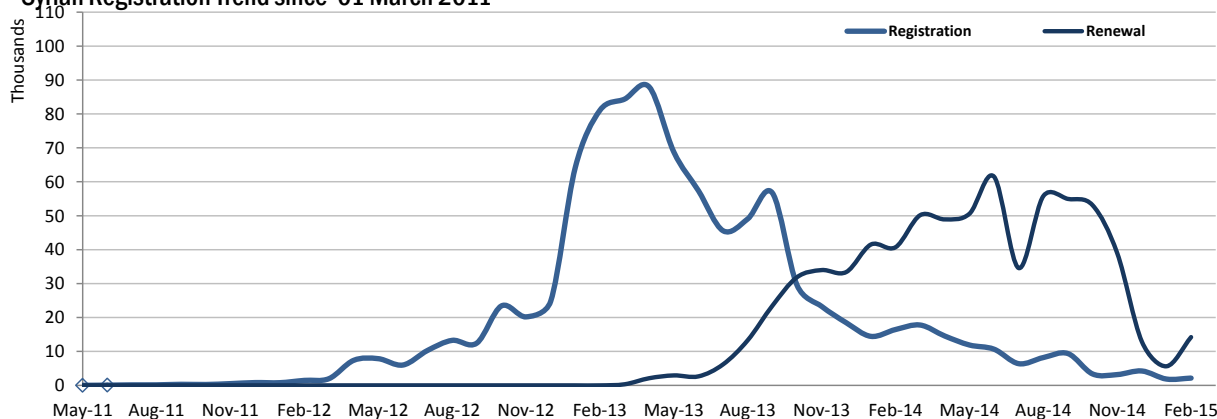
Biometric Statistics (IRIS)



Age-Gender Breakdown

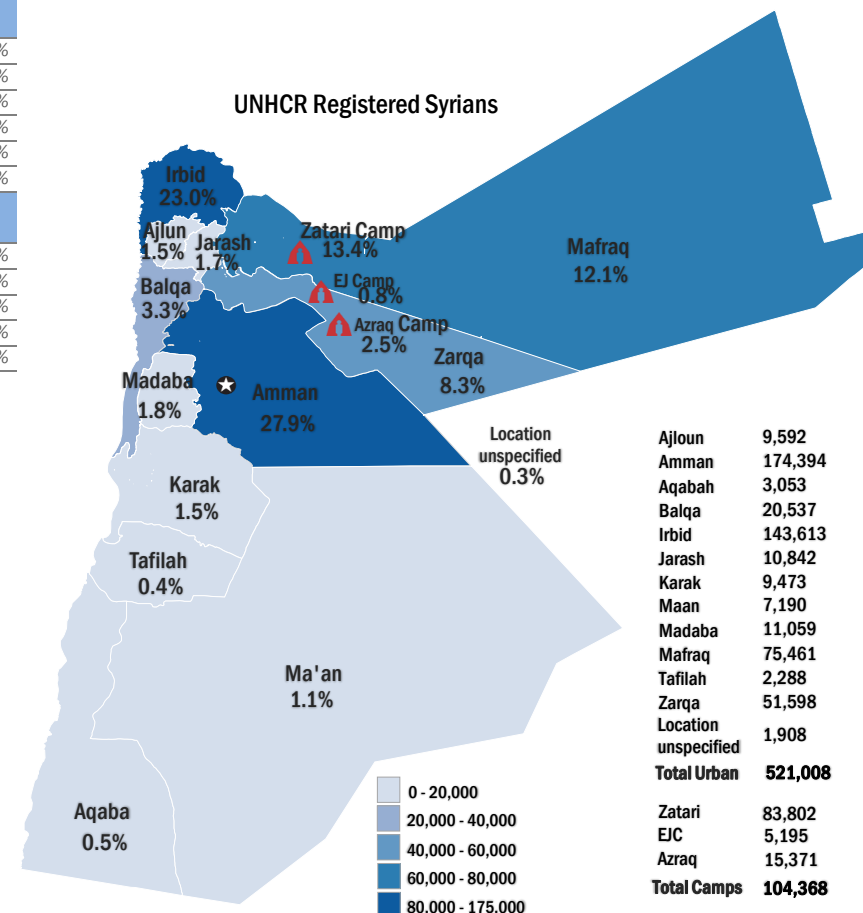


Syrian Registration Trend since 01 March 2011
