Further strong winds are expected later this week with some heavy rain or thunderstorms at times.

Tuesday night

Sea conditions between Turkey and the Greek Islands are generally expected to improve through Tuesday night as strong to gale force southerly winds gradually ease.

Wednesday

There is a risk of heavy rain and thunderstorms affecting the west coast of Turkey and perhaps the Greek Islands too. Sea conditions may temporarily deteriorate near any heavy showers, but otherwise winds should remain lighter than at the start of the week.

Across the mainland, some slow-moving heavy and perhaps thundery showers are expected to develop during Wednesday. Not all places will see these showers, but where they do occur, it may lead to increasingly muddy conditions under foot.

Thursday and Friday

Light winds on Thursday morning will be replaced with strengthening southerly winds across the Aegean during the afternoon and persisting through Friday. Heavy showers or longer spells of rain will become more widespread, before clearing later on Friday.

Past event analysis would suggest the forecast sea conditions would result in a reduction in arrivals to the Greek Islands as waves become increasingly dangerous for small boats later on Thursday and throughout Friday.
