Population Planning Figures for Niger


Despite the improvements in Mali situation, the security remains a challenge. While UNHCR Niger recorded the voluntary returns of some 4,000 refugees since January (50% of total returns since 2013), 4,000 other refugees arrived so far, mainly from Anderboukane, Inekar and Menaka.

Successful projects in 2014

DOMESTIC ENERGY

Provide cooking fuel to refugees so that they will no longer sell parts of their food rations in order to purchase firewood for cooking, thus helping both refugee families and the environment.

ZONE D'ACCUEIL

Refugees who are living in hosting areas are the most resilient. As result, WFP has now limited its food allowance to the most vulnerable people. The lowest rates of GAM

UNHCR and all partners will work from the same location to provide to urban refugees all services and activities relevant to them.



COUPON-BASED FOOD DISTRIBUTION

Improve refugees dignity by offering them the choice of the type, of the timing and the place of receipt of food assistance.


FILETS SOCIAUX / SAFETY NETS

Ensure reintegration into their areas of origin for returnees (Niger Nationals) currently living in refugee camps.


