











Water Capacity in Litres









Individuals Per Latrine





Water Capacity per Tent in Litres




Attending Public School 1198 1137 775 **Active Settlements** Less than 4 Settlements

Children living in settlements less than 4 tents are twice as likely to not be attending formal public education as children living in settlements 4 tents or larger

Attendance of Children in Formal Public

50% of all Informal Settlements reported Children not attending formal public education, which is in line with 2015 VASyr findings which reported 52% of children not attending school.



Indicators for 3rd Sweep 2016 (June-July)

- Do children have access to recreational and child protection activities in this Informal Settlement or in a nearby one? (Yes, No, Do Not Know)
- Where do residents of the informal settlement receive primary health care? (Primary Health Care, Private Clinic, Pharmacy, or Mobile Medical Unit)

The Inter- Agency Mapping Platform (IAMP) is a nationally coordinated data collection platform for all Informal Settlements. The IAMP is released on the first of every month, with every even IAMP being a complete sweep of the Informal Settlements.
