			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Purchase order for cleaning items and toolkits for the municipal workers</li> <li>• Maintenance forms has been issued in order to avoid duplications and misunderstanding with the municipal technical team</li> <li>• Distribution is going smoothly through our hygiene kiosks without tensions, lines and aggressive behaviors so far</li> <li>• Site management gave approval for the concrete bases for the bins and for moving the K2 storage closer to the hygiene kiosk</li> <li>• Site improvements along the site (wall repair, concrete stairway etc)</li> <li>• 4 cleaning activities took place in Elaionas</li> </ul>	
7	Skaramagas	IFRC/DRC/IMC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• IMC: installed boiler for the shower</li> <li>• Emergency Solid Waste Management, with additional truck (1 or 2 times per week)</li> <li>• IFRC: Information that population has reduced to 1500</li> <li>• WWT for 1500 person – preparing TOR for consultant – international tender</li> <li>• Municipality will take care of cleaning the drainage and iFRC the piping with pressurized water</li> <li>• Diarrhea cases – IMC tested the water, results were ok</li> <li>• Demonstrations - NGOs were advised not to work inside for 3 days- garbage trucks and desludging trucks were not able to access the site</li> </ul>
