AOB	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reminder of the Hygiene Promotion (HP) meeting on 26 SEP at 15.30, hosted in NCA office. • Discussion on Hygiene Kiosks; agencies were asked to share lessons learned, best practices and challenging on running Hygiene Kiosks in Attica and Central Greece at the Hygiene Promotion meeting. • Discussion on whether the HP meetings could be arrange to be at the same weeks than National WASH WG and Regional WASH WG are to make them easier to attend. Proposed date for the following meeting: 12 OCT, then every other week. • It was discussed that the vaccination of WASH staff, as proposed by HP meeting group, will be discussed at the HP meeting. • It was proposed that the coordination of cleaning actors in the sites is discussed at the HP meeting, with the reference to the increase of municipality personnel for solid waste management. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Asses if the work load for cleaning as well as other various works has decreased for the Organizations, after the employment of municipal workers for the sites. • Reminders: Next Regional Wash WG: 11 OCT Current National Wash WG: 22 SEP Next National Wash WG: 11 OCT

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apostoli/IOCC/NCA informed that they will provide 5 sanitary containers for the new site, Thiva. • The Ministry of Interior and the Army have introduced a more strict policy for entering all camps, and for any works or constructions to be done there. The government is asking for specific Electromechanical and Constructions plans. This has an impact on the speed and the ease of starting new necessary works. There is a common uncertainty on how the permissions should be obtained. • DRC informed that in Central Greece they have to inform a joint governmental committee “KEPOM, kepom@ypes.gr” which includes a cluster of ministries as well as the Army in order to get a permission to get the works done.
