JRP- Social protection task force update.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- At the first JRP-Social Protection task force meeting on 31 Aug: The Comprehensive Vulnerability Assessment (CVA) report was reviewed and finalized (Task Force includes MoSD, UN agencies, INGO and local governmental entities). The situation analysis for the social protection sector is still under review.- MoPIC shared the new project summary sheets (PSS). The new PSS will include more details on projects activities in addition to detailed breakdown of targeted beneficiaries nationality, gender and geographical coverage of implementation. JRP task forces will have a projects formulation and finalization workshop on the Dead Sea during 4-6 Oct. cabinet approval of the JRP 2017-19 to take place on 21 Dec.
Update on VAF	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- VAF-BN task force presented three options for the revised Basic Needs sector tree. Option 1 and Option 3 were preferred. Option 2 was considered complicated with a narrow focus.- The merits of Option 1 lie on its simplicity, while Option 3 was considered more sensitive to the precariousness of the case (family) situation. The Task Force created a 'revised Option 3' that combines the merits of Option 1 and 3 and provides finer distinctions in vulnerability levels.- BNWG members asked for a revised calculation of Option 3 using dependency ratio rather than debt per capita to determine if results are significantly different.- For further info on the VAF-BN task force presentation please follow the link: http://data.unhcr.org/syrianrefugees/working_group.php?Page=Country&LocationId=107&Id=71
