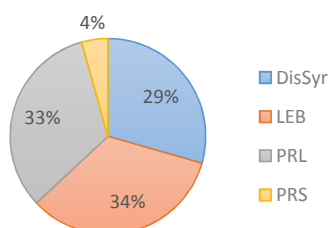

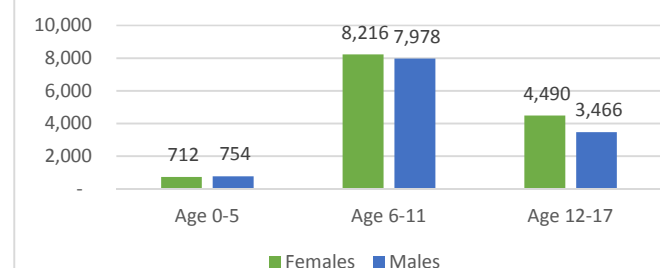

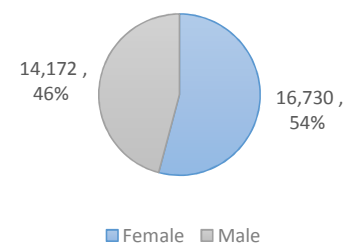
Cohorts - Structured PSS



Sex - children sensitized



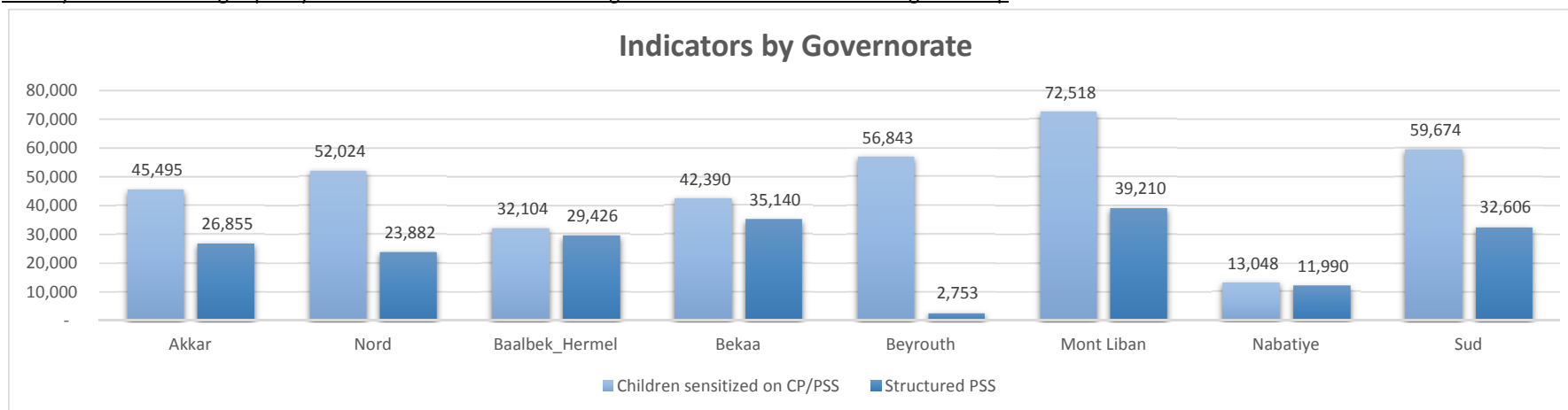

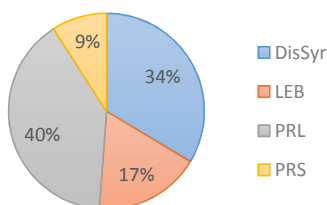

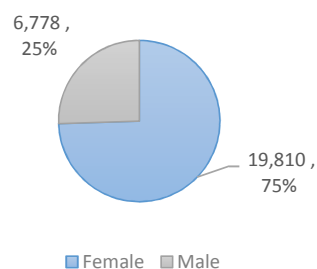

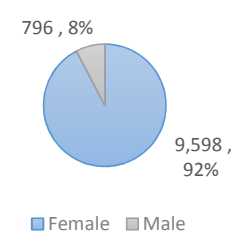
Caregivers sensitized - Cohorts



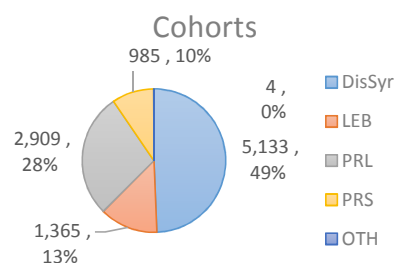
Caregivers sensitized - Sex



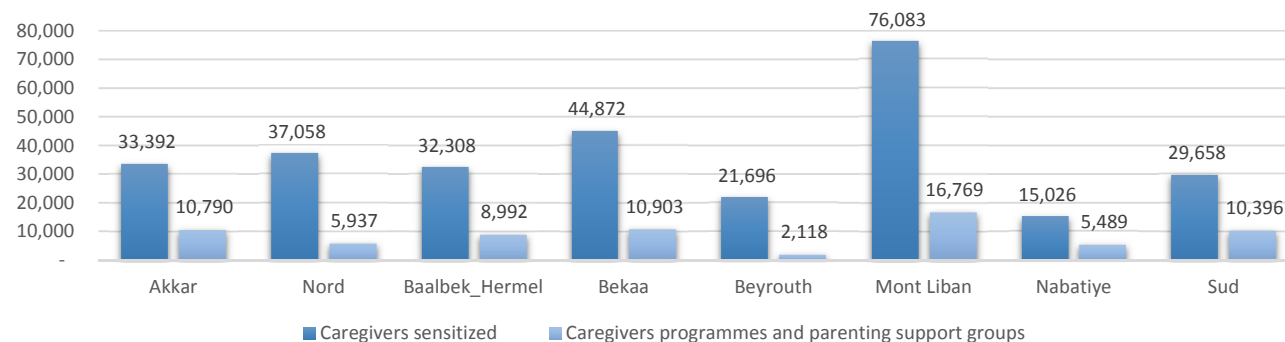

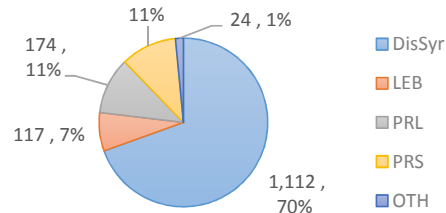

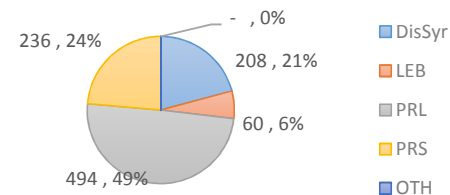
Focused PSS - Cohorts



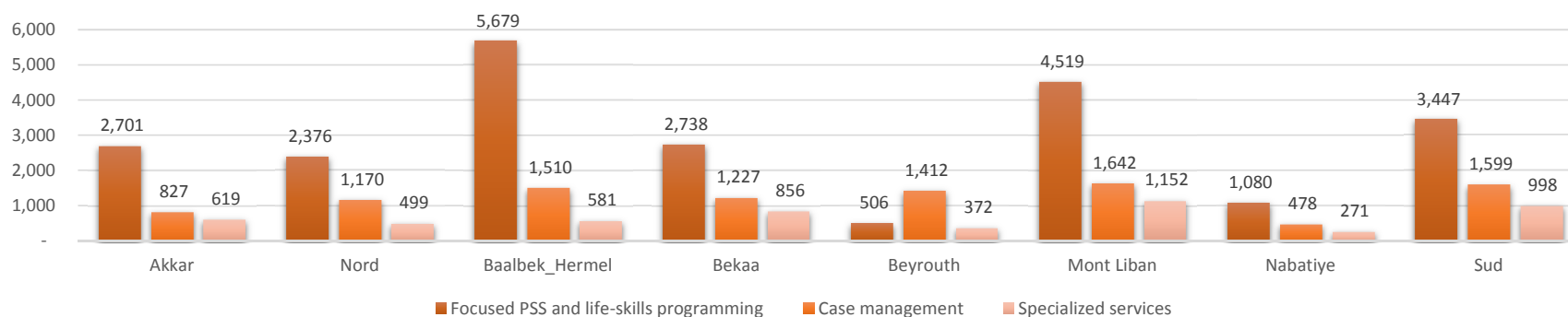
Case Management - Cohorts

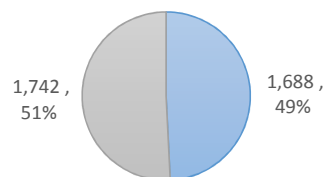

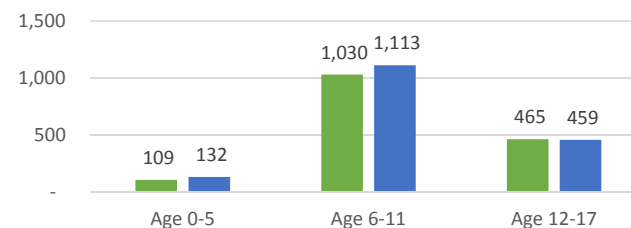

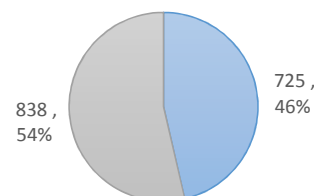

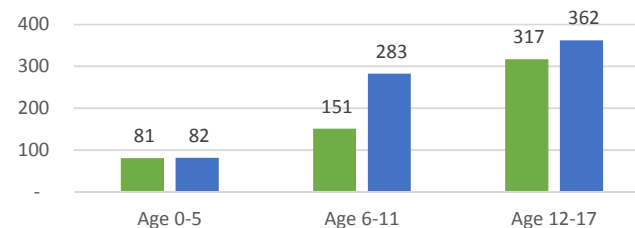

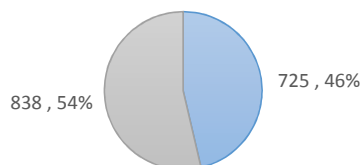
