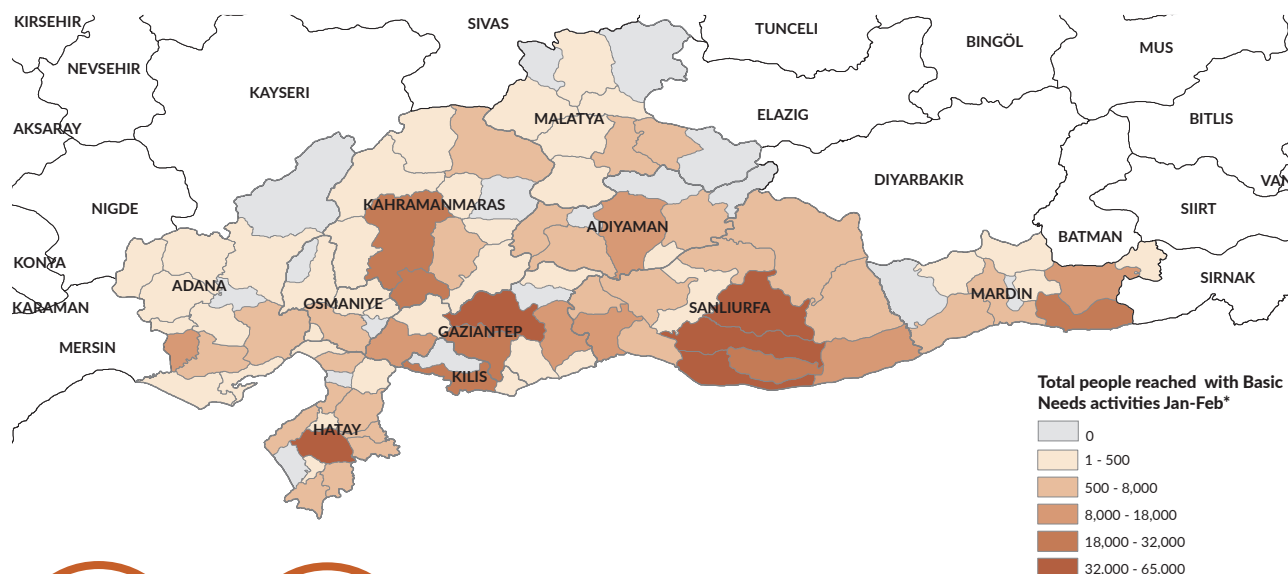

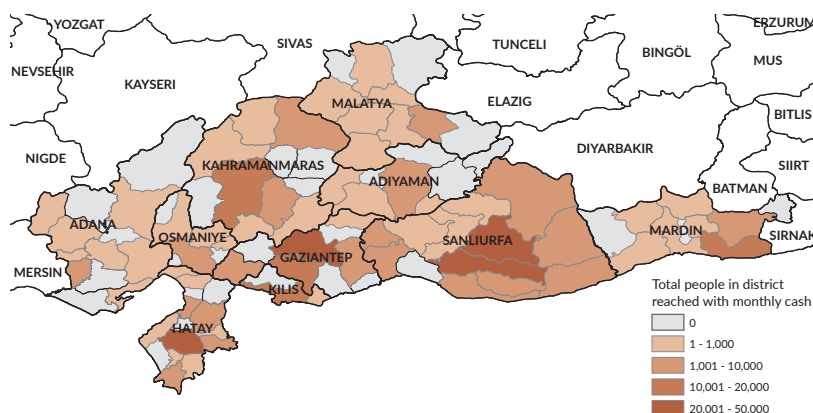

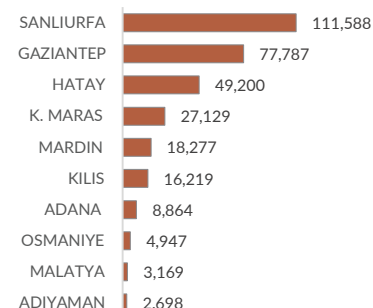

Total people reached by with monthly cash by district

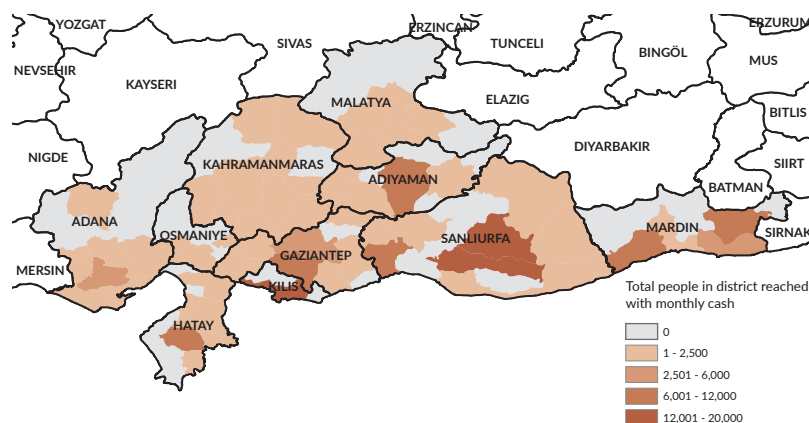


Total people reached by with monthly cash by province

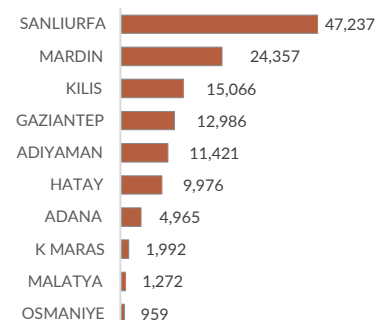


## 130,231 people reached with one-time cash-based interventions

Total people reached by with one-time cash by district

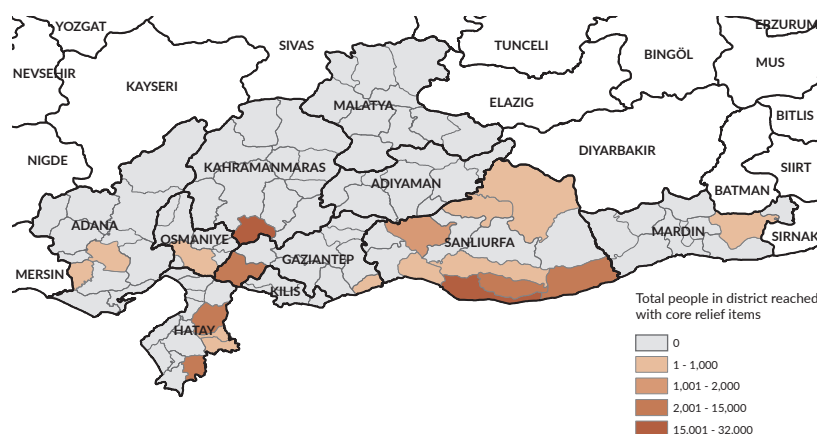


Total people reached by with one-time cash by province

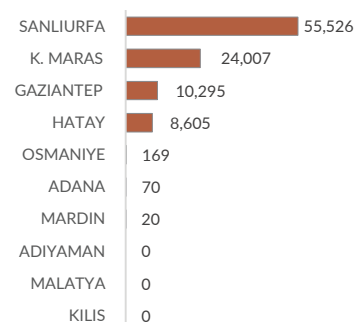

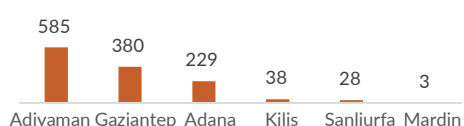
Total people reached by with core relief items by district
