

Angola Emergency: Population Information Update



Overview: This document presents Asylum Seekers population statistics of Congolese recently pre-registered in the provincial capital of Dundo and surroundings in Lunda Norte Province. The complex emergency in Kasai Central Province in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) began with the violent uprising of a local militia (Kamuina Nsapu) in August 2016. Since then the crisis has spread to provinces of Kasai, Eastern Kasai and Lomami.

Since March 2017 more than **25,169*** people including women and children have fled violence in the Kasai region and sought asylum in Dundo. The asylum seekers are located in two reception centers, notably Mussunge and Cacanda and in host communities along the border and in Dundo.





Areas of Origin in Democratic Republic of Congo


Majority of Asylum Seekers fled Kamonia Territory in Kasai Province. Below are the top 2 villages they fled from
