

<b>DRC Complaint Response Mechanism</b>		<b>Camp Women's Association Update</b>	
During the Month of February DRC CCCM received one formal letter of complaint in OTG-N regarding stolen materials from our DRC Protection office. DRC is looking into the event and what measure can be taken to improve security.  DRC is highly committed to listening to the IDP communities we serve and to international commitments on accountability as a result DRC CCCM will be focusing on improving our Complaint Response Mechanism (CRM) over the coming months. Through the month of March we will be holding focus group discussions with our camp based staff and IDP communities for their input on how best to improve our CRM system. Updates will follow in next month's report.		DRC is working to establish Camp Women's Associations (CWAs) in its camps this year. It is our vision that the CWAs will act as a semi-formal source of female leadership in the camps that can provide a counterweight to the influence of the CMCs. Approximately 10 women will be identified to represent their communities during monthly meetings with DRC CCCM staff. As they raise camp priorities, CCCM will provide support to address these issues with a community-driven approach, raising concerns through appropriate avenues as needed.  OTG-N is one of four camps where a CWA has already been established. Through a snowball sampling method, DRC staff identified 10 women who are considered well-respected community members who are highly involved in camp-life. The first meeting of the OTG-N CWA is scheduled for 16 March.
