

CHOLERA SITUATION REPORT DAY 83

12th August 2017 AS AT 5PM

There were four admissions today at the CTC as at 5pm, one turned negative for cholera RDT and three turned positive for cholera RDT.

Patient line listed yesterday Nuela Nyanzira comes from K3 protection not K3 Z1 B1.

We had one discharge to the community linked to community health workers.

Details of the discharged patient;

- Zamniba Eugene K3 protection

Cumulatively we have line listed 106 patients as of 12TH August 2017.

Out of the 106 patients admitted, all 106 were tested for RDT cholera (100%), 60 turning positive and 46 turning Negative.

Cholera RDT positive stands at 57%.

As at 5pm 12TH August 2017, we have 5 patients admitted at the CTC.
