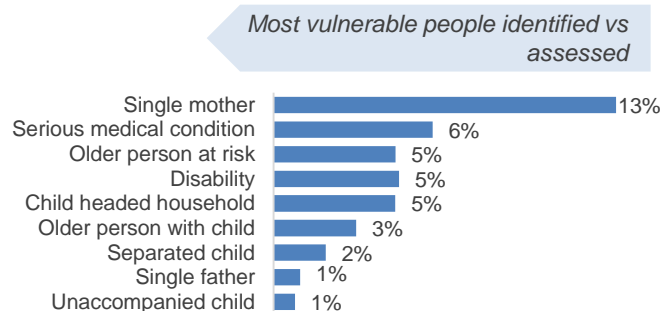

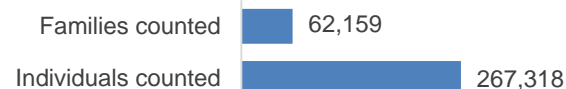
PROTECTION

30% of the registered households have been identified with a vulnerability

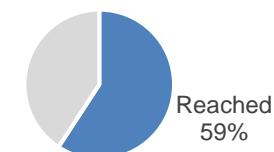


FAMILY COUNTING

105,000 families targeted

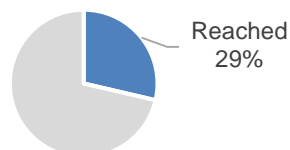


SHELTER/NFI

NFIs distributed



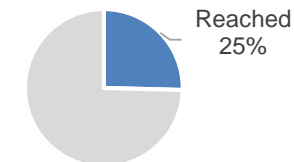
250,000 refugees targeted for Non food items distribution

- Over 43,800 refugees have access to latrines
- Over 63,500 refugees have access to water

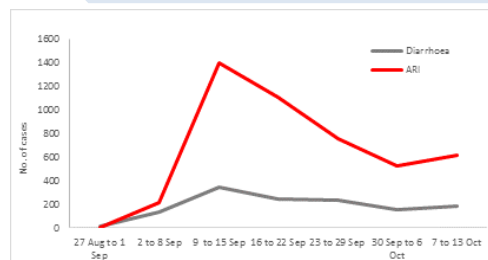
250,000 refugees with access to water targeted



HEALTH

Diarrhea & acute respiratory infection (ARI) cases among new arrivals

- 2 Diarrhoea Treatment Units and 3 health posts established
- Over 27,900 refugees received medical attention
- Over 60,000 refugees received OCV²
- Over 10,330 refugees (6 m. to 15 yrs) received MR³ and OPV⁴



FOOD & NUTRITION

- Over 8,850 refugees received food through the community kitchen per day.
- 3,623 children admitted for SAM/MAM treatment
- 3,034 pregnant and lactating women admitted for treatment
